Sub: Visit of DG, SAI to SAI NERC Imphal on 18th & 19th June, 2015

The undersigned visited SAI NERC Imphal on 18th & 19th June, 2015. Gist of decisions emerged during the said visit are indicated hereunder for appropriate action by the concerned Division :-

1.	<p><u>SAI NERC, TAKYEL REGIONAL CENTRE:</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • As suggested by cycling coach, construction of cycle track within the regional sports complex was agreed by DG, SAI and instructed CPWD for submission of plan & estimate. • DG, SAI assured to sanction Rs. 1.00 crore during this financial year for purchase of sports equipment. List of sports equipment required is to be submitted. • Some coaches hailing from other regions requested for transfer, if not in their home town, at least to the region closer to their home town. DG agreed to look into their problem and the coaches to submit application. • As requested by some of the staff for upgradation/promotion, DG, SAI agreed to take up the matter with the Personnel Division. • During the visit of Parliamentary Committee on Official Language, it was discussed about appointment of Hindi typist and SAI authority had assured for immediate appointment. Details of candidates with recommendation of the committee have been submitted to Director (Pers) for necessary approval. • Details of vacancies along with requirement to be submitted to Director (Pers.) for necessary action. • DG has instructed for proper maintenance of the campus of Regional Centre. • To meet the water requirement at Regional Centre, Takyel, EE(CPWD) was instructed to submit detailed plan & estimate. • DG, SAI desired that the MP hall at Regional Centre, Takyel be completed by Sept-Oct, 2015. The EE(CPWD) has assured to complete the work by the deadline. Layout plan of the Regional Centre is to be prepared and submitted at the earliest. • Swimming coach suggested for construction of one swimming pool and CPWD was asked to submit detailed plan and estimate. • The existing MP hall at Regional Centre requires maintenance for leakage of the roof. Detailed estimates to be prepared for submission to Head Office. The electrical wiring, toilet, doors of the STC hostel in Takyel also need immediate renovation. Plan & estimate to be submitted at the earliest. • DG desired that all football ground should be of natural grass. 	<p>Secretary, SAI, Regional Head of SAI NERC, Imphal, Director (Pers & Cg.), Director(Infra)</p>
2.	<p><u>SAG, KHUMAN LAMPAK, IMPHAL</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Estimate for renovation of the girl's hostel for SAG Imphal has already been submitted to Director (Infra). DG, SAI assured to expedite it. • DG desired that the existing MP hall at Khuman Lampak be renovated, particularly made leak-proof, electrical wiring and the damaged flooring estimate to be prepared and submitted for necessary approval. 	<p>Director(Infra.)</p>

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> DG observed that the quality of construction work of MP hall cum 40-bedded hostel at Khuman Lampak is very poor. DG desired for inquiry about the poor quality of work. CPWD Executive Engineer was informed about this and has assured that whatever defects are there, shall be rectified and completed within 30 days. In-charge, SAG Imphal, Shri Ibomcha Singh suggested for engagement of one physiotherapist as SAG being Contact Sport Centre, most of the inmates are prone to injuries. 3.	<u>Marykom Regional Boxing Foundation (Academy)</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> As requested by Ms. Marykom, DG agreed to increase the SAI sponsored boxers from present strength of 20 to 40. Selection has to conducted to the additional intake. Provision for construction of one hostel was also discussed so as to enable the academy to have residential facilities particularly for rural area boxers. 	Regional Head of SAI NERC, Imphal, RD(Ops)
4.	<u>SAG Utlou</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> DG, SAI was not happy with the living conditions of the inmates and instructed the CPWD engineers to complete the construction of the new 100-bedded hostel at the earliest and instructed to shift the inmates in a phased manner. CPWD engineers assured to complete the work by Sept, 2015, including the MP hall. DG also desired that the existing hostel accommodation be renovated and girls trainees who are under day boarding scheme, should also be provided residential facilities. DG, SAI also instructed CPWD to submit plan & estimate for proper maintenance of the football ground. DG also instructed for submission of work-plan reflecting the percentage of work completed and actual date of completion. SAG, Utlou is facing acute shortage of water and therefore instructed for soil testing report with plan and estimate for deep tube well. 	Regional Head of SAI NERC, Imphal / Director(Infra)
5.	<u>Water Sports at TakmuSendra Moirang</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> DG visited the Water Sports Complex at TakmuSendra on 19th June, 2015 and had an interaction with the Kayaking, Canoeing and Rowing sportspersons and the officials of the Association. DG desired that a detailed report may be submitted for starting a SAI sponsored water sports scheme. 	Regional Head of SAI NERC, Imphal, RD(Ops)
