1. Position

Physiotherapist, Indian Senior Women National Hockey Team

2. Primary Role:

To assess and treat any injuries that occurs during training sessions or matches using appropriate treatment modalities.

To provide a coordinated return to sport rehabilitation program for any injured athlete. To provide onward referrals for injured athletes to appropriate sports medicine professionals for diagnosis and further consultation.

3. Term of position:

The successful applicant will be engaged by Hockey India / Sports Authority of India on a contract up to 31 December 2020 ie the 2020 Tokyo Olympic Games Cycle, subject to the satisfactory completion of a 6 month probation period.

HOCKEY INDIA

Hockey India (HI) is the National Sports Federation for the sport of Hockey in India. Hockey India is affiliated to the International Hockey Federation, Asian Hockey Federation and Indian Olympic Association.

Hockey India has the responsibility to develop and manage the national teams programmes and works in close coordination with the Sports Authority of India (SAI) in the delivery of the national teams programmes across senior and junior hockey.

SPORTS AUTHORITY OF INDIA

The Sports Authority of India (SAI) is a body set up by the Government of India. The objectives of SAI are to promote and broad-base sports in the country and to implement schemes / programmes for

achieving excellence in sports in different disciplines at international level in order to establish India as a major sporting power. It also act as an interface between the Ministry of Youth Affairs & Sports and other agencies concerned with the promotion/ development of sports in the country on the other hand, i.e., State Govt., U.T. Administration, IOA, National Sports Federations, Sports Control Boards, Industrial Houses, etc.

ROLE SUMMARY

Reporting to the Indian Women Hockey Team Chief Coach and the High Performance Director, Hockey India, the Physiotherapist will be responsible to ensure the health and fitness of the Senior women core probables. In the event of injury, the Physiotherapist must assess, investigate and treat the player providing a modern approach to sports in jury.

The Physiotherapist is responsible for reporting all injuries; their nature, treatment regime and rehabilitation period to the Chief Coach and High Performance Director.

The Physiotherapist is also responsible for the ordering and recording of any stock, consumables or equipment used by the Senior women team.

RESPONSIBILITIES

1. REPORTING & COMMUNICATION

The Physiotherapist will be required to submit regular reports to management on the status of the national team and core probables with regard to analyses of injuries and treatment program plans.

2. KEY RESPONSIBILITIES

Development & Planning

- Provide athlete screening on a regular basis and give findings to Director, High Performance.
- To liaise with the Chief Coach and the Scientific Advisor regarding athletes conditioning and rehabilitation programs.
- o To liaise with Hockey India to ensure essential equipment and consumables are available for training camps and tours.
- o To act as a senior member of the touring party responsible for the prevention of injury (strapping, massage) and recovery of athletes.

Administration

- o Tokeep comprehensive records of all athletes treatments.
- o Report any significant injuries to Director, High Performance with an appropriate treatment plan.
- Submit reports on athlete's injury status and welfare following any tours or domestic competitions.

Practical Involvement

- o Attend all trainingsessions.
- o Attend all matches
- o Provide treatment to athletes as required
- To oversee pre-habilitation and rehabilitation sessions in conjunction with the Scientific Advisor.
- o To liase with the team Masseur
