Expression of Interest (EOI) for Seeking Knowledge Partner to design, develop, deliver and train faculty in Sports Coaching & Exercise Science and Sports Science Courses For National Centre for Sports Coaching, NS NIS, Patiala

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1. PREAMBLE

1.1 The National Centre for Sports Coaching, Netaji Subhash National Institute of Sports, Patiala (hereinafter referred as "NCSC NS NIS"), which is the academic wing of the Sports Authority of India, an autonomous body under the Ministry of Youth Affairs & Sports, Government of India, invites proposals/ Expression of Interest from prestigious Universities/ Sports Educational Institutes working in Coach Education and Development (hereinafter referred to as "Prospective Collaborator"), to partner or collaborate with NCSC NS NIS for the design, development and delivery of Sports Coaching & Exercise Science, Sports Science and other Sports related Educational Courses as per international standards. Once empaneled, only these agencies will be eligible to collaborate and affiliate with NCSC NS NIS for the requirements as detailed below.

1.2 The intent of the Eol is to empanel eligible universities/sports educational institutes worldwide who can help NCSC NS NIS to enhance sports coaching education in India, create a coaching development framework and help in conducting research in technical, tactical and skill development aspects of coaching and training of athletes.

1.3 The Prospective Collaborators are requested to submit documents in soft copies or supportive web links as mentioned and in alignment with Annexure I and II to the following mail id in password protected PDF format/compressed folders within the last date of submission.

1.4 NCSC NS NIS reserves the right to amend/vary or discontinue the process of this EOI or any part thereof with its absolute discretion at any point of time.

1.5 Any pre-submission query should be sent to the Contact mail ID before the above mentioned pre-submission conference date in the attached format as per Annexure-III. Further, any observation/comments regarding EOI clauses during EOI

submission stage should also be attached in the format at Annexure III along with other documents.

1.6 The EOI proposal submitted and all subsequent correspondence and documents relating to the same exchanged between the Prospective Collaborator and NCSC NS NIS, shall be written in the English language. However, the language of any printed literature furnished by the Prospective Collaborator in connection with its EOI may be written in any other language provided the same is accompanied by an English translation and, for purposes of interpretation of the Proposal, the English translation shall prevail.

1.7 The empaneled Prospective Collaborators may be considered for further collaboration on similar or relevant initiatives undertaken by NCSC NS NIS or SAI or Ministry of Youth Affairs & Sports, Government of India as deemed fit in addition to this requirement.

2. INTRODUCTION

2.1 Sport Authority of India is an autonomous body under the Ministry of Youth affairs and Sports, Government of India created for promotion of sports and entrusted with the responsibility of implementation of sports policies, schemes for training of athletes and coaches and related sports initiatives across the country. NS NIS, Patiala is the main academic centre of SAI. The present campus of the NIS was inaugurated at Patiala on 7 May 1961 mainly with the aim to study the standard of sports in the country and to provide quality Coaches in different sports and games. The NIS Diploma in Sports Coaching was started in 1963 to groom and train sportspersons for a coaching role. Besides being the academic centre of SAI, the Institute is home to training of elite sportspersons for international competitions, across disciplines.

2.2 NS NIS Patiala has been the premier institute for sports education in the country, assisting the Indian sports ecosystem with qualified coaches and sports science staff who have worked with the top athletes of the country. To further enhance the coaching education both in sports specific disciplines and sports science disciplines the **National Centre for Sports Coaching (NCSC)** has been set up by the Government of India, Ministry of Youth Affairs & Sports at NS NIS Patiala. Under the aegis of the NCSC, the Coaching and Sports Science education is to be further strengthened and new courses to support the growing demand from the sports environment are to be launched. The NS NIS, Patiala, is conducting a wide range of courses from skill development to Masters in Sports Coaching. The details of Courses are placed at Annexure IV. *Further details about NS NIS may be found on https://nsnis.org/*.

2.3 The institute also operates as a National Centre of Excellence (NCOEs) for training elite athletes at its state-of-the-art facilities. NS NIS Patiala is highly regarded for providing athletes with high quality sports science support focused on elite competition performance.

2.4 The green campus of the Institute provides world class training facilities to the Coaches and athletes. The infrastructure includes two state of the art outdoor synthetic tracks, multiple halls for various sports, world class gymnasiums, an all-weather indoor pool, an outdoor pool with diving facilities, hockey synthetic ground and numerous other smaller facilities. The institute provides in living facilities for almost 2000 athletes and trainees with state-of-the-art kitchens and recreational facilities.

2.5 During its almost 60 years of existence, **20,400 Coaches have passed out with the Diploma in Sports Coaching**. In addition to the Patiala Campus, the institute also runs two other campuses at Bangalore and Kolkata from Sports Authority of India's centres. These centres boast of international standard infrastructure and are training venues for many National teams preparing for Olympics and other international events. NIS Patiala has also trained almost 37000 entry level Coaches in the 6 week certificate program. Besides over 200 Coaches have also earned their Master's degree in Sports Coaching from the institute.

2.6 The athletes trained at this premier institute have distinguished themselves by winning a large number of medals at the Asian and Commonwealth Games and Championships. However, the major highlight is the Bronze Medal won at the 2008 Olympics in Boxing. During the last 2 decades, in Athletics alone our athletes have won 18 Gold, 17 Silver and 24 Bronze Medals. Besides numerous medals have also been won in Weightlifting, Fencing, Boxing, Hockey and Judo.

2.7 As part of realizing the vision of newly established NCSC at NS NIS Patiala, and to meet the growing need of quality coaches and sports science staff at all levels within the sports ecosystem, NCSC NS NIS is seeking collaboration and partnership with leading Universities/Sports Education Institutes of the world who are renowned for imparting education in Sports Coaching, Exercise Science and other sports related educational programmes and subject areas.

3. SCOPE OF WORK

3.1 The Prospective Collaborator will design the curriculum in collaboration with NCSC NS NIS as per the global standards of sports coaching and exercise science education. The expected courses for which curriculum may be designed are as follows:

- a) Undergraduate and Graduate Degrees in Sports Coaching & Exercise Science.
- b) Diploma in Sports Coaching (Specific sports discipline).
- c) Certificate course for Performance coach.
- d) Certificate course for High Performance coach.
- e) MSc in various disciplines of Sports sciences.
- f) Short certificate courses in disciplines of Sports science.
- g) High Performance Leadership Courses for Sports Administrators.

h) Any other courses for enhancing sports education.

3.2 The empanelled Prospective Collaborator will develop the course structure along with processes and timelines for imparting the courses.

3.3 The empanelled Prospective Collaborator will conduct training of faculty members and other trainers as required.

3.4 The empanelled Prospective Collaborator will create an assessment mechanism and train the faculty members in conducting candidates' assessment.

3.5 The empanelled Prospective Collaborator may jointly certify candidates who pass the courses completing all deliverables by the way of awarding dual degrees or certifications.

3.6 The empanelled Prospective Collaborator will facilitate faculty and student exchange programme between themselves and NCSC NS NIS for durations as required and mutually agreed.

3.7 The empanelled Prospective Collaborator will facilitate NCSC NS NIS in conducting research in technical, tactical and skill development aspects of coaching and training of athletes.

3.8 The empanelled Prospective Collaborator will facilitate NCSC NS NIS in designing and developing a coaching development framework.

3.9 The Proposal should be submitted along with relevant documents as per Draft Proposal mentioned at Annexure II – Draft Proposal Format.

4. ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

The eligibility criteria which will be used for shortlisting the Prospective Collaborator for further collaboration and affiliation are listed below.

- A. University/Sports Educational Institute should be in existence for at least 15 years.
- B. University/Sports Educational Institute should have a dedicated sports coaching and exercise science department.
- C. University/Sports Educational Institute should be conducting degree or diploma or certificate courses in sports coaching and exercise science and / or other sports educational programmes for at least 10 years.
- D. University/Institute should have faculty, lab and research activities in at least 2 of the following sports science departments -

- i. Sports Physiology.
- ii. Sports Psychology.
- iii. Sports Biomechanics.
- iv. Sports Biochemistry.
- v. Sports Anthropometry.
- vi. Sports Medicine.
- vii. Strength & Conditioning.

- Prospective Collaborators who score 70 or more marks in the above Evaluation Criteria shall be empanelled.
- Proposals from the Prospective Collaborators who do not meet the required Qualification Criteria mentioned above will be treated as non-responsive and will not be considered further.
- Prospective Collaborators should provide soft copies of relevant documents/ declarations or web-links to substantiate the data provided against each evaluation criteria

6. EMPANELLMENT OF PARTICIPANTS

6.1 The EMPANELLMENT will be based on the compliance to Qualification Criteria and marks scored in Evaluation Criteria.

6.2 The term of EMPANELLMENT for EACH OF THE REQUIREMENTS will be for a period of 5 years, extendable by 2 years by mutual consent. However, the collaboration/affiliation once finalised may continue as long as mutually agreeable.

6.3 Empanelled Prospective Collaborators may be considered for further collaboration on similar or relevant initiatives under NCSC NS NIS or SAI or Ministry of Youth Affairs & Sports, Government of India as deemed fit as already brought out at Para 1.6 and the terms and conditions for such collaborations would be decided on case to case basis.

6.4 Further, NCSC NS NIS reserves the right to issue separate tender/EOI rather than restricting to only Empanelled Collaborators for any reasons as deemed fit by NCSC NS NIS.

- NCSC NS NIS or any of its affiliates reserves the right to cancel this request for EOI and/or invite afresh with or without amendments, without liability or any obligation for such request for EOI and without assigning any reason.
