## SAI Felicitates the Silver Medalists of Junior Women's Asia Cup Hockey Team members

The Indian Junior hockey team made the nation proud having won a Silver in the 6<sup>th</sup> Junior Women's Asia Cup, Bangkok held from 27<sup>th</sup> June – 7<sup>th</sup> July. The team displayed exemplary grit and determination while playing with China in the finals held on 7<sup>th</sup> July.
