Its main objective is to promote, organize, and regulate the sport of Archery in India and to prepare Indian Archers for international sporting events. India today is among the top 10 Archery-playing nations and aspires to be among the top 3 to 5 with podium finishes at the Olympics Games 2028.

Responsibility:

- To select and groom young Archers into international champions at the National Centre of Excellence for Archary.
- Coach elite Archers to achieve a higher level of performance.
- To guide strategic planning, coaching programs, and goal setting for Archers, monitor performance, track data, and provide detailed analytical insights.
- Ensure best practice approaches to Archers and individualized planning and reviewing throughout the pathway.
- Inspire Archers to reach their potential by driving a culture of continuous improvement, learning, and innovation.
- Any other responsibilities assigned by Archery Association of India to achieve its objective.

Qualifications:

- Should have at least 5 years' experience of coaching high-performing teams and delivering medal-winning performances at major international competitions.
- Proficient in the latest techniques and training methodologies in sport.
- Demonstrated effective leadership and management skills.
- Experience in creating and maintaining a thriving team culture and environment with the ability to communicate well in English.

Tenure:

A four year term up to 2028 Olympic Games, subject to performance review after 2026 Asian Games.

Remuneration:

Will not be a constraint and will be commensurate with qualifications.

Head National Coach-Recurve will report to the High Performance Director or in his absence to the person assigned by the President/Secretary General of AAI.
