Agenda Item No. 3: Proposal for hosting U-21 Khelo India Women Hockey League from Hockey India under Khelo India Scheme

During the DPAC meeting held on 20.02.2020, a proposal was received from Hockey India requesting support for the conduct of the U21 Women Hockey League in collaboration with Khelo India. Hockey India requested an amount of Rs. 32,80,000 (Rupees Thirty Two Lakhs Eighty Thousand Only) to organize the league in three States was approved, copy placed at **Annexure 3-A.**

- 2. A model was evolved to organize Khelo India Girls League wherein Roles and Responsibilities were outlined to organize Khelo India Girls League copy placed at **Annexure 3-B**
- 3. The above mentioned league could not take place on the decided dates due to COVID Pandemic. Considering the current improved situation, Hockey India has submitted the revised proposal to conduct the Khelo India U21 Women Hockey League. To organize the league Hockey India has requested for an amount of Rs. 39,22,675/- (Rupees Thirty Nine Lakhs twenty Two Thousand Six Hundred and Seventy Five Only), copy placed at **Annexure 3-C**

^{*}Phase 1 and Phase 2 will be a round robin format. The final ranking of the 14 teams will be determined after the completion of the first 2 phases. Phase 3 will consist of classifications matches where each team will play a minimum of 3 matches.

- i. **Fixed Cost** includes the cost of Trophies, Medals, Certificates, Uniforms, Travel Allowances for CMs, ITOs, NTOs, corner flags, stop watches etc.
- ii. **Variable cost** includes the cost of match balls, DA for CMs, ITOs, NTOs, Volunteers, Accommodation for officials, Refreshment, Branding etc.







- iii. **Prize Money**: During the Lockdown, players had to bear the year round expenditure. In the U-21 Khelo India Women's Hockey League, Boarding& Lodging, Transport, Refreshment etc. will be borne by the participating team. Therefore, in order to incentivize and to attract more and more talent, Sports for Women vertical proposes a Prize Money of INR 15 Lakhs for the top 8 Teams. Bifurcation of Prize Money is placed at **Annexure 3-D.**
- 5. **Talent Identification:** Vertical of Khelo India Talent Identification, through Talent Identification Committee to identify and develop talent in various sports disciplines through robust talent identification mechanism. U-21 Khelo India Women's Hockey League will give a platform to KITD to identify the talent considering the number of matches that will be played by the teams.
 - Nature of expenditure and admissibility will be finalised by the Director General, SAI.
 - The expenditure incurred to organize the league could be more than those estimated and therefore, Director General, SAI is authorized to allow expenditure up to 10% beyond the approved amount.

The proposal was placed before the PAC held on 26.10.2021 wherein it was recommended to place the same before the DPAC for the approval of:

Providing funds for an amount of Rs. Rs. 55,00,000/- (Rupees Fifty Five Lakhs only) for the proposal received from Hockey India for the conduct of U-21 Khelo India Women Hockey League under the "Sports for Women" vertical of the Khelo India Scheme.







Agenda Item No 4: Adoption of State centre to Khelo India State Centre of Excellence in <u>Uttarakhand.</u>

The DPAC vide its meeting dated 05.03.2020 decided that existing facilities in States/UTs should be upgraded as Khelo India State Centre of Excellence (KISCE), under the Khelo India Scheme. Assistance should be in the form of bridging the gaps in sports equipment, high performance managers, coaches, sports scientists, technical support, etc.

- 2. It was desired by the DPAC that project proposals be called from States to identify gaps and assessment done for converting the existing sports facilities into Excellence Centres. In this context, letter was sent to all States /UTs requesting for DPRs. So far 27 Centres in 26 States/UTs have been notified & of the remaining 10 States/UT's, the proposals from the State of Uttarakhand DPR is put up for consideration of Project Appraisal Committee (PAC) of Khelo India.
- 3. The proposals received for KISCE from the State of Uttarakhand is as below:

<u>Agenda Item No. 05: Opening of District Wise Khelo India Centres in Himachal Pradesh</u>, Telangana, Madhya Pradesh and Assam

DPAC vide its meeting dated 04.06.2020 decided to establish 1000 Khelo India Centres over the period of 04 Year with a maximum 01 KICs per District (except for district in North East state, J&K, A & N Island, Lakshadweep and Ladakh, where there would be 2 KIC per districts. 390 KICs have already been notified. In this regard, proposals from the following States/UTs for Government organizations/centres are received within the purview of guidelines.

A. Opening 12 KICs in the State of Himachal Pradesh

The brief of the proposals is given below:

- 3. Opening of 16 Khelo India Centres in Madhya Pradesh with budget estimate for annual recurring expenditure @ Rs. 80.00/- Lac and One time grant @ Rs. 80.00/- lac.

Agenda Item No 6: Grant of Out of Pocket Allowances (OPA) to the Khelo India Athletes of Indigenous Games (04) for the F.Y. 2021-22.

The DPAC vide its meeting dated 04.06.2019 had sanctioned scholarship to the Khelo India Athletes (KIAs) of the four (04) existing Indigenous Games under Khelo India Scheme @ Rs. 10,000/per month per athlete for a period of 01 year. Subsequently, DPAC vide its meeting dated 04.09.2020 approved the allowances on similar lines for the F.Y.2020-21. This agenda was placed before the DPAC on 23.09.2021 wherein it was directed to place a revised agenda before the next DPAC.

2. It is to be mentioned that as against 335 KIAs only 283 KIAs have been given the Out of Pocket Allowance. The details of the number of KIAs sanctioned & annual financial implications on account of allowances are as under:

- 3. In this context, it is to note that due to the impact of Covid- 19 pandemic, the list of KIAs could not be revised and the existing list was continued. However, since the situation is gradually returning to normalcy, the revision of the list is in process.
- 4. Further, it is pertinent to note that allowance amount of Rs. 84, 90,000/- (Rupees Eighty Four Lakh Ninety Thousand Only) has been released for the 1st quarter i.e. April- June'2021 of the current F.Y. 2021-22.
- 5. In this regard, it is submitted that Rs. 10 Crore has been projected for PRITG Vertical as a part of Khelo India Budget for the F.Y. 2021-22, which includes the total annual financial implication of Rs. 4.02 Crore towards the allowances of 335 KIAs (out of which as mentioned above, an amt. of Rs. 84.90 Lacs has been already released).

In view of the above, the agenda is placed before DPAC for the following:

- I. The ratification of an amount of Rs. 84, 90,000/- (Rupees Eighty Four Lakh Ninety Thousand Only) released during the 1st Quarter of the current F.Y. 2021-22.
- II. Decision on extending the benefit of allowances to the KICs for the indigenous games till 31st March, 2022 and approval of an amount of Rs. 3.171 Crores as budget for the same.







Agenda Item No. 7 :- Approval of Funds for Project Management Unit for the period of 1st November, 2021 – 21st Jan 2022

DPAC (Khelo India) in its meeting dated 03.01.2020 vide its agenda item no 1 (Annexure – 7A) approved the proposal for setting up of Project Management Unit (PMU) at an overall cost of Rs. 4,78,66,464/- for 12 months for engaging technical experts and resources with relevant domain knowledge in order to ensure the efficient and effective implementation of initiatives under the Khelo India Scheme.

- 2. The 52nd GB Meeting held on 13.03.2020 ratified the appointment of M/s. Ernst & Young LLP for 12 months at Rs. 4,78,66,464/-, extendable by another 12 months subject to satisfactory performance. It was subsequently felt that the service of PMU is required in full capacity for one more year.
- 3. Accordingly, a proposal for extension of services of M/s. Ernst &Young LLP for 1 year was placed before the 96th meeting of Finance Committee held on 09.03.2021, which concurred the approval of extension of the PMU till 30th June 2021.
- 4. Subsequent to the approval of the 96th FC on 09.03.2021, DPAC vide its 24th meeting held on the same date i.e. 09.03.2021 approved the proposal for extension of services of M/s. Ernst &Young LLP till 30th June 2021.
- 5. 97th meeting of the FC held on 19.05.2021 approved the proposal for the extension of the services of M/s. Ernst & Young LLP for the remaining period i.e. from 01.07.2021 till 21.01.2022; which is approved by the Hon'ble Chairman of the Governing Body on file. In view of the above, the agenda was placed before 29th DPAC held on 23.09.2021, wherein, DPAC approved the funds upto 31st October with an observation to provide information to MYAS about the work done by the PMU.
- 6. A sum of Rs. 1,74, 48, 836/- has been incurred for the period from Feb 2021 till July 2021. In compliance with the directions of DPAC as mentioned above, the information was submitted to MYAS. In view of this, a sum of Rs. 1,19,66,616/- (calculated for engaging 13 resources for 2 months and 21 days i.e. from 1st November, 2021 to 21st January,2022) may be approved for the remaining period. Necessary provision has already been made in the budget for the Khelo India Scheme for the F.Y. 2021-22 (*Annexure 7B*).

The above matter is placed before DPAC for approval of Funds for Project Management Unit for a period of 1st November, 2021 – 21st Jan 2022 at an expected cost of Rs. 1,19,66,616/-.
