Proposal for conversion of STCs and SAG Centres under State Level Khelo India Centre vertical of Khelo India Scheme of MYAS.

Option 1: Proposal for conversion of 30 STCs Centres and 9 SAGs Centres.

In order to groom the junior level sports persons in the age group of 10-18 years, SAI is implementing SAI Training Centres (STC) and Special Area Games Centre (SAG) Scheme across the country. Presently there are 59 STCs & 20 SAG Centres operational across the country. To find out the effectiveness of implementation of STC Scheme, the Quality Assurance of 58 SAI Training Centres was carried out by the Quality Council of India (QCI) through National Accreditation Board for Education & Training (NABET). Based on the report of the Quality Assurance, the centres which scored weighted score of 50 and above will be converted into State Level Khelo India Centre Scheme (Mega/ Medium State Level Khelo India Centres) for the financial support. The list of 30 STCs is placed at **Annexure-I**. The NABET carried out Quality Assurance of STC Centres on the following parameters:

- ★ Governance and management
- ★ Infrastructure
- ★ Faculty and HR
- ★ Trainer Trainee Development
- ★ Sports Science Consultancy & Linkages
- ★ SAI Quality Assurance Procedure
- ★ Overall Performance

Similarly, based on the internal categorization the centres falling in the “A” category as per the list attached placed at **Annexure-II** are proposed for conversion into Mega/ Medium State Level Khelo India Centre Scheme for the purposes of financial support. The STC centres having good infrastructure and good performance were categorized in A category.

The copy of the financial norms duly approved by the 47th Governing Body of SAI applicable under STC/SAG Scheme is placed at **Annexure-III**.

FINANCIAL IMPLICATION ON CONVERSION OF 30 STC INTO STATE LEVEL KHELO INDIA CENTRES

To convert 30 existing STC centres having scored 50 and above weighted average score on Quality Assurance as Mega/ Medium State Level Khelo India Centres with annual budgetary provision of **Rs.37.03** crores of which funds to the tune of **Rs.18.52** crores to meet the expenditure w.e.f. Oct.’2018 to March’2019. The Centrewise annual financial implication on 30 STC Centres is placed at **Annexure-IV**.

FINANCIAL IMPLICATION ON CONVERSION OF 09 SAG INTO STATE LEVEL KHELO INDIA CENTRES

To convert 09 existing SAG Centres having been categorized as category “A” centres (Internal Assessment) as Mega/ Medium State Level Khelo India Centres with annual budgetary provision of **Rs.15.27** crores (based on the approved schemes norms) of which funds to the tune of **Rs.7.63** crores to meet the expenditure w.e.f. Oct.’2018 to March’2019. The Centrewise annual financial implication on 09 SAG Centres is placed at **Annexure-V**.

Similarly, based on the internal categorization the centres falling in the A category as per the list attached placed at **Annexure-VI** are proposed for conversion into Mega/ Medium State Level Khelo India Centre Scheme for the purposes of financial support. The SAG centres having good infrastructure and good performance were categorized in A category.

Recommendation: The PAC recommends conversion of 30 STC into Mega/ Medium State Level Khelo India Centres under Khelo India Scheme for the purposes of financial support to the tune of **Rs.18.52** crores to meet the expenditure w.e.f. Oct.'2018 to March'2019 and the PAC further recommends conversion of 09 SAG into Mega/ Medium State Level Khelo India Centres under Khelo India Scheme for the purposes of financial support to the tune of **Rs.7.63** crores to meet the expenditure w.e.f. Oct.'2018 to March'2019.

The approval of DPAC is sought on the above recommendation made by PAC.

Option 2: Proposal for conversion of 11 STCs and 7 SAG Centres.

In case above is not feasible, the Chairman of Project Appraisal Committee (PAC, DDG, SAI) is of the opinion that from the existing STCs & SAG Centres (other than situated in the Regional Head Quarters and the STC/SAG centres where academies are being established) about 15 to 18 STCs & SAG Centres may be considered under State Level Khelo India Centre vertical. Considering that the North Eastern States are having abundance sports talent, therefore, special focus is required to be given for STC/SAG operational in these states. Accordingly, the following STC/ SAG Centre are proposed to be covered for financial assistance under the State Level Khelo India Centre vertical.

The left over states will be covered at later stage. Therefore, to convert **11 STCs** and **7 SAGs** Centres as State Level Khelo India Centres with annual budgetary provision of **Rs.20.03** crores for 2019-2020 and funds to the tune of **Rs.5.01** crores to meet the expenditure for remaining 3 months (**Jan. to March-2019**) during the financial year 2018-19. List of 11 STCs and 7 SAG centres is attached in **Annexure-VII**.

Chapter 1

Introduction

The **Sports Authority of India (SAI)** is an apex National Sports body set up in 1984 by the Ministry of Youth Affairs and Sports, Government of India for broad basing and bringing excellence in sports across India.

The joy felt by Indians over the success of the shuttlers, shooters and the boxers in the international events is truly understandable. At the same time the question that dominates everyone's mind is that a country of 1.3 billion people can fetch medals in single digits in Olympics. The government is making efforts by identifying, training and motivating talent through its various schemes. Training of talented children when initiated in a focused manner at an early age can reap huge benefits.

The mandate given to SAI is promotion of sports and in the process it has been able to contribute significantly in identification and nurturing of talent which has translated into some medals at international level. For undertaking any activity in sports training the most important factors are infrastructure and trainers. Through its STC scheme SAI has reached out to remote areas of the country and established training and nurturing centres. In the whole eco-system there are some gaps which hamper the process of training in sports.

The Sports Authority of India has undertaken the initiative of assessment of its training facilities under the STC scheme and the task of evaluation was assigned to NABET. The whole process was completed in two phases-

- pilot phase- wherein assessment of 18 STCs was undertaken
- phase II- assessment of remaining 40 STCs was carried out

Chapter -2

Quality Assurance of 58 Sports Training Centers:

NABET, QCI conducted the assessment of 58 STCs under SAI in two phases, as assigned by SAI. The Quality assurance of 18 STCs of SAI in 2017 and the remaining 40 STCs in 2018. The reports of both the phases have been submitted to DG SAI.

The QA assessment was carried out along the following 7 parameters:

- Governance and management
- Infrastructure
- Faculty and HR
- Trainer Trainee development
- Sports Science consultancy & Linkages
- SAI QA Procedures
- Overall performance

A criteria was developed in the form of a questionnaire and the questions were placed under these 7 parameters. The criterion developed in the pilot phase had 194 questions and the marks ranging from 0 to 3 were allotted against these questions. The total marks attainable in the assessment process were 469. The questions were subjective in nature as per the defined options. The list of 18 STCs which were chosen to do the assessment of their existing facilities are placed in **Annexure A**.

In the second phase wherein assessment of 40 STCs was carried out, the criteria used in the pilot phase was utilized, although a little modification in the language of questions and the marks allocation was brought in. **The reasons of bringing functional and cosmetic changes in the questionnaire were:**

- ✓ The criteria earlier was quite subjective and as it was felt that the STCs could not be clearly placed on a scale of 0-4 so the marking scheme was made binary.
- ✓ Some questions were found to be repetitive and hence they were clubbed.
- ✓ In the initial phase it was observed that the STCs did not have much budgetary flexibility so the questions in the budget section were reduced to basic minimum.
- ✓ As the STCs are directly under the control of REGIONAL CENTRE/SAI they did not seem to have flexibility in terms of hiring staff, salary structure, management/administrative issues, annual report, website, role of parents, IR issues etc. and hence the questions pertaining to these parameters were removed/clubbed in the revised questionnaire.

Considering the above, the criteria was modified such that 194 questions were reduced to 177 under the same gradation parameters. The marks automatically were reduced from 469 to 180 due to binary responses in each question. However the weightage accorded to the parameters continues to be the same. The list of 40 STCs assessed in the second phase is placed in **Annexure B**.

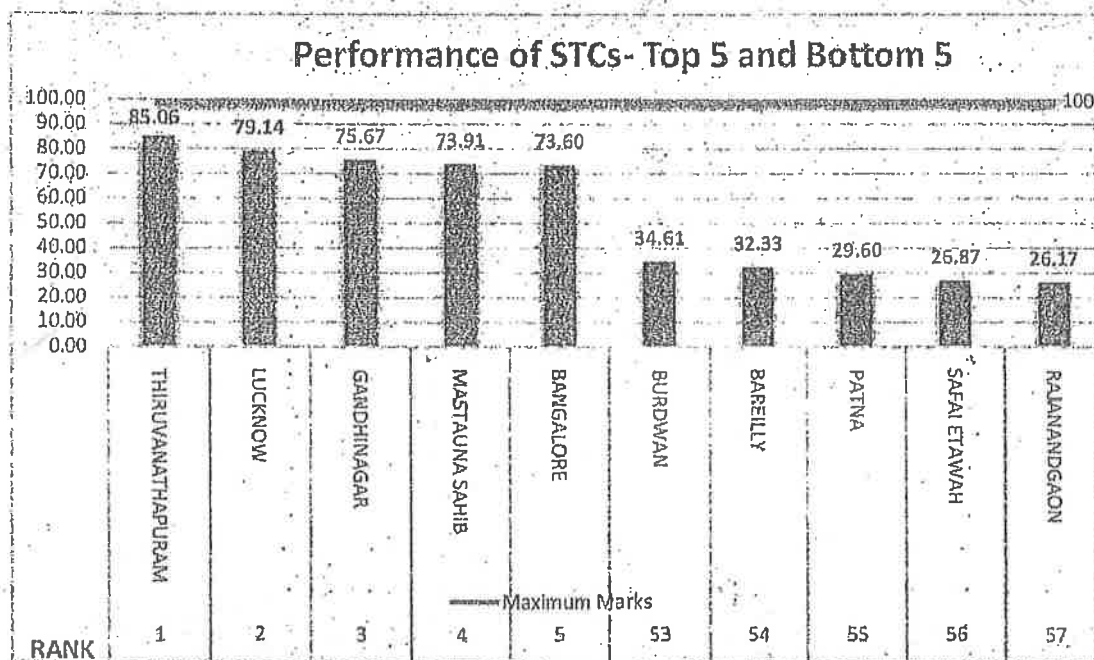

Chapter 4

Performance of STCs- Top 5 and Bottom 5



The table depicts the performance of top 5 and bottom 5 Sports Training Centres from the list of a total 58 (18 + 40) STCs assessed during phase I and phase II of the projects. The performance is based on weighted average calculations to bring coherence between both the projects.

It is inferred from the table that the STC Lucknow, Gandhinagar and Bangalore have secured rank 2,3 and 5 respectively. These are the STCs collocated with the RCs and hence have been outstanding in all the 7 parameters justifying their ranks. STC Thiruvananthapuram has secured the 1st position establishing itself as one of a kind among the rest. It is pertinent to mention that STC Thiruvananthapuram is governed by LNCPE, Trivandrum which has secured the highest average marks i.e.124 as compared to the rest of the RCs. A detailed report on the analysis on the RCs is mentioned in the report titled as 'Quality Assurance of 40 STCs'. STC Mustana Sahib, governing RC- Chandigarh, has secured 4th position and obtained exceptional marks in governance and management, infrastructure & SAI QA procedures and eventually obtained the weighted average as 73.91 out of 100. This STC has just one issue addressing to shortage of staff and rest all adhere to satisfactory grounds.

On the other hand the bottom 5 STCs are viz. Burdwan, Bareilly, Patna, Safai Etawah and Rajanandgaon. Out of these STC Rajanandgaon has ranked last i.e. 57th from all assessed STCs. One of the primary reason for such a performance is the location of the STC which lies in LWE area in the state of Chhattisgarh. The strength of the sports ecosystem is weak eventually resulting in low intake of trainees. Thus it can be concluded that the no. of operational disciplines is directly proportional to the strength of the sports ecosystem in the vicinity of the STCs.

A weak sports ecosystem is not only confined to Rajnandagaon but actually common to the poorly performing STCs viz. Burdwan, Bareilly, Patna, Safai Etawah.

STC Burdwan is located in the Burdwan district of West Bengal which is a remote area having rough accessibility. STC Bareilly doesn't have much trainee intakes due to reduction in the no. of operational disciplines as compared to the numbers at the time of inception.

STC Patna has performed poorly as it was placed at 18th position (the last among the rest) during phase I of quality assurance of 18 STCs. It failed to deliver effectively in any of the 7 gradation parameters.

Chapter 5

Recommendations

After conducting an extensive study of the Sports Training Centres, the key recommendations are shared below:

1. **Identification of Key Performance Indicators for STC:** for any organization to sustain and progress it is crucial to have its goals and objectives fixed and available to all. These goals and objectives may vary from STC to STC as the games being played, facilities available and the regional requirements (India being a diverse country) are not uniform. The STC's requirements need to be elaborated so that all the stakeholders are aware of what is the expectation.
2. **Adopt a PPP model:** The PPP model will help STC in-charge get some funds to popularise the sports and eventually the talented youth will be pulled into formal training processes. Additionally it has been seen from our experience in cricket and badminton that when big corporate houses and PSUs begin to take interest in the training of sportspersons the success rate increases.
3. **Closure or reallocation/relocation of resources of poor performing STCs:** Some STCs are not able to meet any of the mandates with which they were made operational and also the infrastructure as well as staff availability is very dismal. In such a case it is good to re-evaluate the RoI on the functioning of the STC and take adequate steps to optimize the resources available with SAI. We recommend the closure of the STCs having 2 or less no. of disciplines.
4. **Fund allocation:** there is no one size fits all policy that can be applied to the funds that are made available to STC functioning in Eastern region or Northern region. As the regional requirements wrt maintenance of facility and procurement of fresh items of consumption vary from place to place, some flexibility must be offered to the STCs. In addition the STCs that are co-located with RCs have an advantage and the funds requirements in such STCs will be different.
5. **Laying down specific occupancy norms in hostel:** the trainees spend most of their time either in school or in the ground/practice area. They do not have much time left to do anything else. In such a case the place that they come back to for relaxation must be

adequate and should serve the purpose. The rooms/space allocated to trainees, it was observed, had no fixed guideline to follow. Some STCs had very cramped accommodation which lowered the performance of the trainees.

6. **Optimizing the funds allocated to the STC based on occupancy of a STC:** STCs where the trainee strength/occupancy is less than 100 are not able to run in a break-even mode. As many grants are linked to the budget of an STC which is in proportion to the trainee strength it leads to tight string budgeting in essential services. Thus it is not possible to facilitate the proper functioning of a STC when occupancy is less than 100 trainees. The funds allocated should not only be proportional to the trainees present but also the number of games being played, the presence of both boys and girls trainees, the regional requirements like extreme weather conditions (rains, cold or heat).
7. **Holistic diet chart and nutrition:** The diet chart in each STC was specific to the region/State where the STC was located. On interaction with trainees and trainers the common issue that was raised was that the sportspersons are not able to perform outside the State is because they do not get adequate diet as per their liking! If the trainees are exposed to variation in diet, not only with local cuisine but also national and sometimes international cuisine, the adaptability to new places and performance will be enhanced. Therefore it is recommended that dietary requirements should not be region specific and a holistic diet chart should be followed so as to develop the taste buds of the trainees irrespective of their region of operation.
8. **Admin and coaching staff to be separated:** There is an acute shortage of staff, especially of the administrative staff in STCs. The coaches are expected to train as well as perform the duties of admin and hostel warden etc, which puts undue strain on them and also hampers their performance. It is the responsibility of SAI to identify the coaches who are unfit to train either due to medical reasons or due to some other personal reasons. These coaches can be trained in IT and other office procedures and thereafter associated only with admin duties.
9. **Involvement of sports volunteers:** As SAI faces staff shortage in STCs it is recommended that they utilize the services of their ex-trainees and other sports volunteers residing in the vicinity of the STCs.

10. **Training of sports persons as coaches:** A coach plays the dual role of a coach as a sport mentor and as an emotional guide. An individual who has performed well in a playground may not have the skill to make a place in the hearts of a young and impressionable trainee. It is therefore essential that a coach be trained in some psychological aspects of dealing with young trainees. Coaching and mentoring needs of a good coach should be identified and regularly updated within the STC staff.
11. **Training Kit:** The training kit allowance provided to the trainees is uniform across the entire country. It must be recognized that the requirements at Jammu and Medak are totally different from those at Imphal. The regional requirements should be kept in mind while allocating funds to trainees for kits. In addition, the sport specific requirements like special shoes, gloves etc are also in great variation. **Therefore it is recommended that trainee kit allowance should cater to regional/climatic conditions as well should be sports specific.**
12. **Certification and re-certification of coaches:** All coaches in SAI have to mandatorily undergo the NIS course before induction. The coaches once recruited do not get to undergo any training or certification program on a regular basis. While the coach performs, mostly in isolation, it becomes very difficult for him/her to learn new coaching guidelines and sometimes even new rules and their implementation. It has been proven that regular updation of professional knowledge not only enhances performance but also keeps an individual motivated. Group interactions help professionals grow. A motivated and learned teacher is enthusiastic, friendly, able to develop rapport with trainees, approachable and always conscious of their status as role models. **It is therefore recommended that coaches should be put on formal certification process** and their competence to coach should be validated every 5 years through re-certification process. Such a process helps individuals grow and learn as well as keeps them on their best so as to maintain the certification.
13. **STC website:** STCs should create their website to reach out to prospective trainees and also to share the all relevant information about the trainee with parents as well as for information dissemination. This will bring transparency to the system.

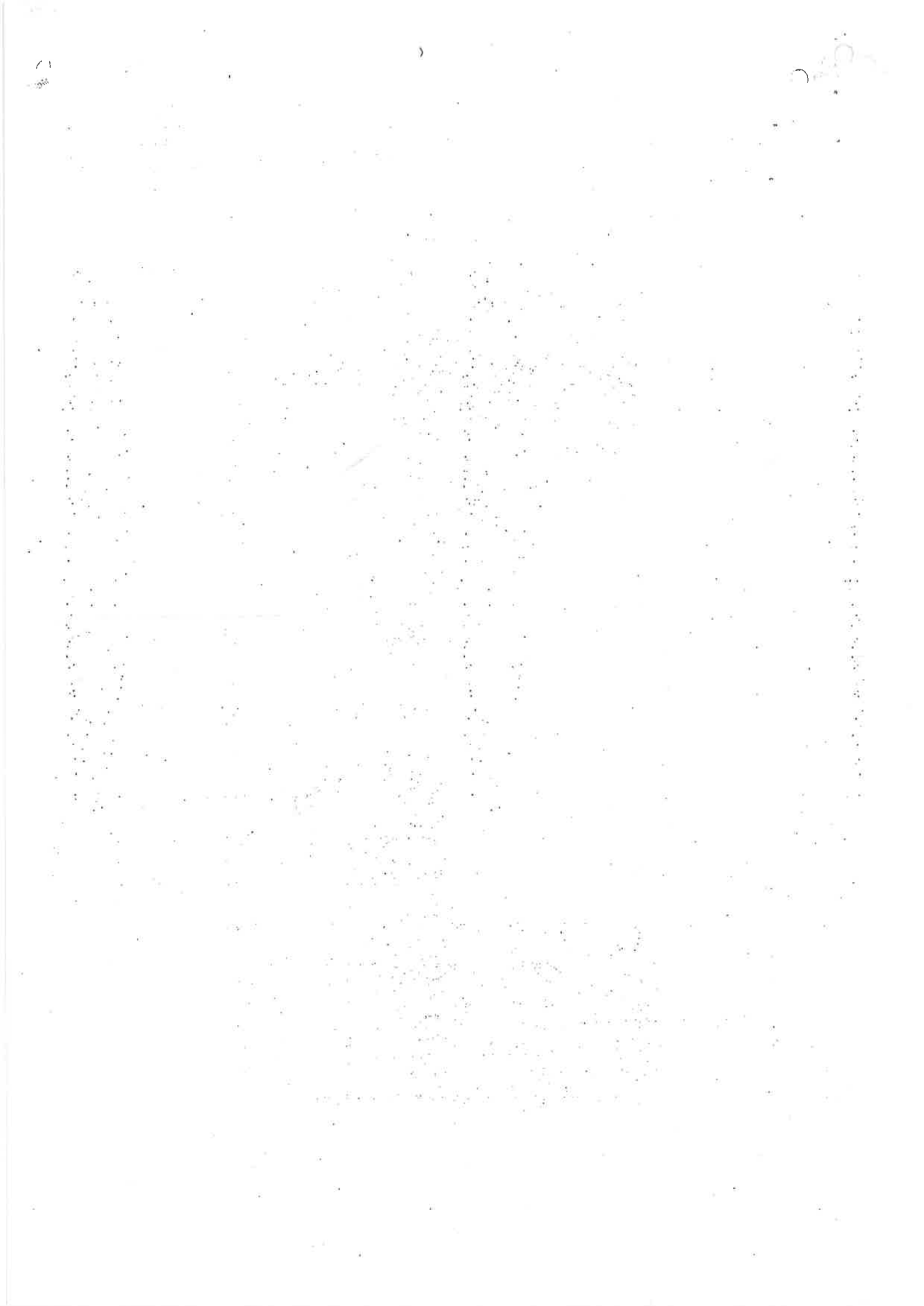
14. **Mentorship programs** to be implemented in STCs. These programs involve visits and sharing of experiences by alumni of the STC. It helps to get motivation from real life heroes. It would benefit the trainees immensely if the alumni of the STC regularly visit and share their life story of struggle and glory with the trainees. Such interactions help build bonds and bridges for development at an accelerated rate.
15. **Sports Science support to STCs:** We all live in a world of exacting and maximizing performance. Sports is no different and it is essential that all parameters that can help an athlete improve should be made use of. Though SAI has made Sports Science facilities available to all Regional Centres, the STCs are far from benefitting in this area. Tie up with local authorities for facilitation of the same would be of immense benefit to the trainees and trainers.
16. **Internal Audit:** In order to build a strong system, self evaluation is very important. **SAI should mandate annual internal audit for all STCs.** The delivery of training should be parametrized and evaluated regularly. This can be achieved by development of structured formats.
17. **Training of Coaches on IT:** as the coaches are expected to fill all the training data on the TIMS it was observed that they are not able to do so as they lack proficiency in handling the platform. Therefore it is **recommended that all coaches should undergo training on TIMS.**
18. **Regular fitness evaluation and mapping of all coaches:** it has been observed that because of lack of regular monitoring and sometimes hectic schedules the coaches tend to neglect their health. It is in the long term benefit of **SAI to promote a culture of fitness and good health amongst the coaches through regular health check ups and fitness tests.**
