Agenda Item No.3

Revision of Legal Fee to SAI Empanelled Counsel at SAI Head Office.

Sports Authority of India is an Autonomous Body under Ministry of Youth Affairs & Sports, established under Societies Registration Act. There are around 85 Court Cases being defended by Sports Authority of India in various Courts of Delhi. These Cases are being defended by panel advocates appointed through open advertisement. A panel of Advocates was drawn in the year 2019 and SAI appointed four advocates at their panel. The fee to be paid for the panel of Advocates (**Annexure -I**) were approved in the 78th Finance Committee and 48th Governing Body of SAI held on 24th March, 2017 and 28th March, 2017 respectively.

On expiry of this Panel, it was decided to go for fresh appointment of panel advocates. In view of this an Expression of Interest (EOI) was floated. It was also proposed to pay the legal fee to the freshly appointed panel advocates of SAI as per the Office Memorandum no. 26(1)/2014/Judl. dated 1st October, 2015 of Ministry of Law & Justice, Department of Legal Affairs (**Annexure-II**)

Accordingly, the following fee structure is proposed to be adopted by SAI from the OM of Ministry of Law and Justice dated 1st October, 2015:

1. The SAI Counsel appearing in Hon'ble Supreme Court - As per the fee proposed under the heading of Group 'B' and 'C' Counsels
2. The SAI Counsel appearing in Hon'ble High Court and Ld. CAT - As per the fee proposed under the heading of Senior Panel Counsel appearing in Hon'ble High Court and Ld. CAT. It is also submitted that no retainership shall be paid by SAI for appearing in the said Courts.
3. The SAI Counsel appearing in District Courts, Labour Court and other subordinate Courts - As per the fee proposed under the heading of Standing Government Counsels appearing in District and Subordinate Court. It is also submitted that no retainership shall be paid by SAI for appearing in the said Courts.
4. The SAI Counsel appearing for Arbitration - As per the fee proposed under the heading of Senior Panel Counsel in Arbitration Matter.
5. As there is no specific charges mentioned in the OM of Ministry of law with regard to Legal Opinion and Legal Vetting, fee shall be paid as mentioned under "Settling of Pleading" under Senior Panel appearing in High Court and Ld. CAT,
6. For drafting MOU/RFP/EOI, SAI shall adopt drafting charges (Sl. No.9) of SLP/Counter Affidavit under Group 'B' & 'C' Counsels of the said OM.

Taking into account the above six parameters the Legal fee to be paid is placed at **Annexure - III**. The proposed legal fee will be effective from the date of fresh panel coming into being. A comparison charge of old and new fee structure is placed at **Annexure - IV**.

Concurrence of Finance Committee is solicited to implement the fee structure for the SAI Panel Counsels as proposed at Annexure - III.

Selection of Project Management Unit for providing development, maintenance and support services for IT Applications at SAI – Revision in Estimates

1. Sports Authority of India has initiated a number of Projects towards e-Governance and digitization in Sports in order to leverage the power of ICT and enable organization of information which is accessible for all the stakeholders. A number of IT projects have been initiated in this regard, which include National Sports Repository System, Khelo India Mobile Application, ACTC Portal, DBT Portal, Khelo India Dashboard, Sports Authority of India Website, Khelo India Fitness Application, FIT India Mobile Application and Website/Portal etc.
2. Accordingly, a PMU was hired for development and maintenance for two years which ended in March 2022. There is continuous need for hiring best resources that will be able to cater to the changing requirements and developments of various IT applications along with maintenance of the various assets.
3. In this regard, an agenda was placed, which was concurred, at the 104th meeting of the FC for Selection of Project Management Unit for providing development, maintenance and support services for IT Applications at SAI for a period of three years. The cost of the PMU was estimated to be Rs. 6,54,53,796/- (Rupees Six Crore Fifty-Four Lakh Fifty-Three Thousand Seven Hundred Ninety-Six Only) for a period of three years, which was arrived as per the Last Purchase Price (LPP) of the PMU hired for the development of NSRS and other IT Application.
4. Accordingly, a tender on QCBS mode was floated on GeM dated 31.03.2022, with 70% weightage to Technical Score and 30% weightage to Financial Score. In addition, only those bids which score a minimum of 70 in technical evaluation criteria (out of a maximum of 100), were eligible for opening of Financial Bid. The bid witnessed participation from two bidders, both of which were found to be non-responsive, on account of non-fulfilment of eligibility criteria.
5. As the first tender could not be materialized, another tender on QCBS mode was floated on GeM dated 25.05.2022, after relaxing the eligibility and experience criteria, so as to ensure maximum participation from the bidders. The second tender witnessed participation from 6 bidders, the details of the evaluation details are indicated below:

7. In view of the above, the estimated price as calculated earlier (on the basis of LPP), may be revised. The second tender was floated on GeM with wide-publicity, non-restrictive conditions along with exemption for Start-Ups and MSME, and sufficient time for bid submission. As such, the lowest prices quoted by the bidders may be treated as prevalent market rates, and can be taken as the basis for arriving at estimated price. Hence, the price estimate for the proposal may be kept at Rs. 7,53,00,000/- (Rupees Seven Crore Fifty-Three Lakhs Only) (inclusive of taxes) for three years, with the detailed price-breakup at **Annexure – A**.
8. It is further submitted that a fresh tender has been floated on GeM on 21.07.2022 with revised estimated cost of Rs. 7,53,00,000/- (Rupees Seven Crore Fifty-Three Lakhs Only) (inclusive of taxes) for a period of three years, in view of the urgency of the situation (and in order to save time) and, in anticipation of the concurrence of the Finance Committee. The finalization of the tender is subjected to the concurrence of the FC.

Concurrence of FC is solicited for setting up of PMU at a total revised estimated cost of Rs. 7,53,00,000/- (Rupees Seven Crore Fifty-Three Lakhs Only) (inclusive of taxes) for a period of three years.

Engaging National Testing Agency for the conduct of preliminary round Fit India Quiz for Schools across the country

I. Background

In order to propagate the message of Fit India among the school children and strengthen its presence in schools, a Fit India Quiz has been envisioned to involve school children across the country. The quiz is the first National-Level Quiz for students which will give out total **cash award of Rs 3.25 crore to schools and students**. In the first edition of Fit India Quiz, 36,299 students from 13,502 schools participated and showcased their knowledge in fitness and sports. Fit India Quiz has become a popular mechanism to align the kids across the country to join the mission of fitness and adopt the fit lifestyle. The four rounds of the quiz will include School Round, Preliminary Round, State Round and National Round. The quiz structure and prize structure in the Fit India Quiz 2022 will be in the similar lines of First Edition of the Fit India Quiz 2021. A circular will be issued to all stake holders in this regard. Copy of the circular and the annexure with all details such as quiz structure; prize structure and other guidelines are enclosed at **Annexure I & II**.

II. Proposal

1. In order to ensure maximum participation, the registration of selected candidates and preliminary rounds have been conceptualized as registration and payment through online mode on a suitable platform and taking the test by individual student using desktop/ laptop / mobile from a convenient place on a sophisticated web-based platform with the adequate security features to ensure fair and transparent conduct of exam. After preliminary market enquiry, the Fit India Mission has identified **National Testing Agency** under Ministry of Education, Government of India as a suitable agency for the conduct of registration and preliminary round, simultaneously, across the country. It has been formed specifically to conduct entrance exams for admissions to Institutions of higher education and it has the capability in delivering exam in over 13 languages. After multiple rounds of discussions, NTA has offered to conduct the exam at Rs. 50 per candidate. Further, the first edition of Fit India has been successfully conducted in collaboration with NTA.

2. It may be seen that the proposal of the NTA is cost effective and without any margin of profit other than overheads and contingency charges. The agency will conduct exam in a cost-effective way.

3. Since, the first edition of Fit India Quiz has been conducted successfully and maintaining the credibility of the quiz is crucial for the sustainability of the Fit India Quiz in the coming years. Considering the reputation and expertise of NTA, and the overall interest of the Fit India Mission, the agency may be considered on nomination basis in accordance with the GFR 194.

Concurrence of Finance Committee is solicited for engaging National Testing Agency (NTA) on nomination basis for the conduct of registration and preliminary round of Fit India Quiz.

It gives us immense pleasure to inform you that Fit India Mission has successfully completed the first edition of Fit India Quiz where 38,298 students from 13,502 schools participated and showcased their immense talent in Fitness and Sports and National Testing Agency has played a pivotal role in the success of the Fit India Quiz 2021.

2. To further strengthen the message of Fit India among the school children and build upon the popularity of Fit India Quiz 2021, we are all set to launch the Fit India Quiz 2022 where we anticipate the greater participation and provide our students a better and bigger platform to prove their talent. Similar to the first edition of Fit India Quiz, this edition too shall consist of preliminary online round conducted by National Testing Agency followed by state wise web rounds to select state champions and final round for the national champion.

3. In this regard, National Testing Agency is to be entrusted for developing the web portal for Fit India Quiz 2022 registration and conducting of preliminary online round. Under the preliminary round the registered students shall be participating in a short 30-minute quiz containing 50 multiple choice questions on fitness and sports including image-based questions. Subject: Fit India School Quiz 2022



2. 3. 4. 5. The quiz is the second edition of the National-Level Quiz for students which will give out a total cash award of Rs 3.25 crore to schools and students.
6. The quiz will also be the second edition of the first-ever fitness and sports quiz to be telecast on India's one of the largest sports television channels, Star Sports as well as on the National TV channel. Students who make it to the national round as representatives of their schools will therefore get a chance to showcase their talent before the entire nation.
7. The four rounds of the quiz will include the following:
 - a. **School Round** : To be conducted by the school to select students for registration in the Fit India Quiz Preliminary Round. It is the responsibility of the school that they encourage maximum students to participate in the Fit India Quiz 2022.

Preface

The Fit India Movement was launched by the Hon'ble Prime Minister in August 2019 with a vision of encouraging every Indian citizen to adopt a physically active lifestyle. Ministry of Youth Affairs and Sports (MYAS) is the nodal ministry for implementing the Fit India Movement in coordination with other stakeholders. The aim of Fit India Movement is to encourage the citizens to include physical activity in their daily lives and to showcase the ease of simplicity of doing activities which can make them fit. In a bid to increase awareness about the importance of physical fitness in our daily lives, the Fit India Mission has conceptualised and conducted multiple events and campaigns. Fit India Movement has been able to mark its presence in more than 4 lakhs schools across the country through Annual Fit India School Week Celebrations and Fit India School certifications.

Objective

To further propagate the message of Fit India Movement among the school children and strengthen its presence in schools, a Fit India Quiz has been envisioned to involve school children across the country. Fit India Quiz, while providing a national platform to students to showcase their knowledge about fitness and sports, also endeavours to create awareness among students about India's rich sporting history, including centuries-old indigenous sports, our sporting heroes of the past and how traditional Indian lifestyle activities hold the key to a Fit Life for all.

Structure of Fit India Quiz

The Fit India Quiz is primed to be the first-of-its-kind nation-wide quiz on fitness and sports for school children. The quiz will have representations from every State/UT in the country and will be a mix of online and broadcast rounds. The quiz format has been designed in an inclusive manner wherein school students from across the country will get an opportunity to test their fitness and sports knowledge against their peers. The quiz will be open for students from all age groups, but the questions shall be framed in a way that can be easily answered by students of class 8 and above.

The questions in the State and National rounds will also include audio-visual and image-based questions to make the quiz interactive and interesting. Preliminary round will also have image-based questions. The Quiz will have questions from multiple themes as outlined below.

- History of Indian Sports, Traditional Sports and Games, Yoga, Personalities etc
- Fitness topics with special emphasis on Indian traditional fitness methods.

- Olympics, Commonwealth Games, Asian Games, Khelo India Games and other popular sports.

The State and National rounds of the quiz will have innovative concepts such as 'phone a teacher/ parent, Ask an Expert, Flip a Question, Trump Card etc. to make it fun, interactive and engaging for the audience. The quiz will also have multi-formats featuring buzzer rounds and audio/video recognition round, etc.

Role of Schools

- The schools will be the key drivers for the propagation and promotion of the quiz within their respective schools which shall be essential for the greater success and participation from students.
- The schools will be responsible for registering minimum two students for the quiz on the Fit India website and shall ensure fair selection process being carried out for the identifying the students.
- The schools to pay the require registration fee per student.
- The qualified school must nominate an additional student from the respective school as quiz partner, based on their discretion, for the State Round to form a team of two quizzers.
- The schools to adhere to the guidelines as available on the Fit India website.
- Schools to make necessary arrangements in case of travel etc for the students.

Role of States/UTs

- States/UTs to ensure wide publicity to Fit India Quiz and encourage to the schools to register and participate in the Fit India Quiz. The information on Fit India Quiz to be shared with all the schools in the state to ensure maximum participation.
- States/UTs to conduct State round in respective states with the support of Fit India Mission and select state/UT champion for National round.
- Event Management agency will be finalised by FIT India Mission.

Role of Fit India Mission

Fit India Mission under Ministry of Youth Affairs and Sports, Government of India shall be the chief benefactor for the Fit India Quiz and shall provide all necessary financial support and guidance to the stakeholders. The Fit India Mission will co-ordinate with the concerned state departments and facilitate in providing guidelines and defining SOPs at various stages of the Fit India Quiz.

Empanelment of Consultants for Infrastructure Works

Sports Authority of India not only undertakes infrastructural work for its own usage but also provides advisory services to State government with regard to its sports infrastructure. Considering the above, a need was felt to empanel agencies to provide consultancy for infrastructural work to SAI. Accordingly, the proposal to empanel agencies for the purpose was approved in the 53rd meeting of Governing Body dated 08.10.2020 subsequent to the concurrence obtained in 92nd meeting of Finance committee. Accordingly, SAI had empaneled eight firms for one year. During the empanelment period the design and concept of following important projects were finalized:

- Sagra Sports Complex, Varanasi.
- Naranpura Sports Complex, Ahmedabad.
- Cooch Behar Sports Complex.
- Deen Dayal Upadhyay, National centre of Excellence at Nagpur
- Model design of Multi-Purpose Halls.
- Integrated High Performance centre.

The empanelment period concluded in October 2021. Therefore, SAI intends to undertake fresh empanelment of agencies to assist SAI in executing infrastructure projects. The following services but not limited to are to be carried out by Consultants:-

- Preparation of Comprehensive scope, concept and specification for the project
- Site Survey, Soil Investigation, preparation of the architectural plans and associated work.
- Preparation of Detailed Project Report (DPR)/PPR/feasibility including Survey and Estimates.
- Any other work required for the purpose.

It is proposed that Consultants may be empaneled through open advertisement at CPP portal.

Concurrence of Finance Committee is solicited for empanelment of consultants for providing consultancy services for infrastructure work.
