DETAILS OF PROPOSAL

1.0 Introduction

- 1.1 Sports today is an integral part of the all round development of the human personality and achieving excellence in sports has great bearing on national prestige and morale. In order to meet the increasing demands of the changing scenario, national as well as international, Government has taken it upon itself to implement programs to promote excellence in sports. At the forefront of the efforts stand the Sports Authority of India (SAI) an autonomous organisation which is a society registered under Societies Registration Act 1860. The Authority is institutionally funded and controlled by Department of Sports, Government of India. Through its sports promotional schemes, SAI supports and nurtures talent in youth, and provides them with requisite infrastructure, equipment, coaching facilities and competition exposure.
- 1.2 The Sports Authority of India (SAI) was established by the Govt. in 1984 and presently primarily has the mandate to achieve excellence at the national and international level.

2.0 Aims & Objectives of SAI

- 3.3 The sports infrastructure existing at these locations comprise the following:

 - (ii) Administrative block / Office Building
 - (iii) Halls for indoor games
 - (iv) Infrastructure for Hockey, Football and Athletics with synthetic turf.

4.0 Scope of Work

I.1 4.1 SAI has an annual budget of about **Rs 70 Crores** for capital works/projects. The Agencies will be empanelled in terms of eligibility criteria for providing consultancy services in sports architecture / Infrastructure at any location in India.

5.0 Eligibility Criteria

- 5.1 The consultancy Agencies should have atleast three years' experience in providing consultancy services in sports architecture/ Infrastructure related projects.
- 5.2.1 Architecture Firms / Agencies should have executed / provided consultancy services for at least fiveworks of at least 1 Crore each related to sports architecture/Infrastructure Or at least one major work related to Sports Infrastructure having minimum value of 5 Crores.
- 5.2.2 The bidders should have an average annual turnover of Rs1 Cr during the last three preceding years (Certificate from CA to be submitted)

- 5.3 The bidders should be solvent for atleast 50.00 Lakh. Recent certificate (not less than one month old) to be enclosed from the banker.
- 5.4 The bidders should not be debarred/blacklisted by any Govt./PSU/Autonomous body/any Registered body (Self undertaking to be submitted)

Presentation should cover

- a) Knowledge of international standard sports infrastructure architecture guidelines.
- b) Approach and methodology for execution of assigned work
- c) Pictorial presentation on completed major sports architecture works
- d) Quality assurance and quality control measures,
- e) Any other information
