DETAILS OF PROPOSAL

1.0 Introduction

1.1 Sports today is an integral part of the all round development of the human personality and achieving excellence in sports has great bearing on national prestige and morale. In order to meet the increasing demands of the changing scenario, national as well as international, Government has taken it upon itself to implement programs to promote excellence in sports. At the forefront of the efforts stand the Sports Authority of India (SAI) an autonomous organisation which is a society registered under Societies Registration Act 1860. The Authority is institutionally funded and controlled by Department of Sports, Government of India. Through its sports promotional schemes, SAI supports and nurtures talent in youth, and provides them with requisite infrastructure, equipment, coaching facilities and competition exposure.

1.2 The Sports Authority of India (SAI) was established by the Govt. in 1984 and presently primarily has the mandate to achieve excellence at the national and international level.

2.0 Aims & Objectives of SAI

- Talent Scouting at micro level & Nurturing talent towards excellence

3.2 SAI also has Training Centres all across the country under the above mentioned Regional Centres and Academic Institutions. There are presently 59 STC's (SAI Training Centers) and 20 SAG (Special Area Games Centre).spread across India

- 3.3 The sports infrastructure existing at these locations comprise the following:
 - (i) Hostels for boys and girls
 - (ii) Administrative block / Office Bldg
 - (iii) Halls for indoor games
 - (iv) Infrastructure for Hockey, Football and Athletics with synthetic turf.
 - (v) Infrastructure for various combat sports like Wrestling, Boxing, Judo etc
 - (vi) Swimming Pools.
 - (vii) Tennis/Volleyball/Basketball etc courts
 - (viii) Gymnasium and Fitness Centres
 - (ix) Other related infrastructure.

4.0 Scope of Work

- 4.1 SAI has an annual budget of about **Rs 70 Crores** for capital works/projects. The Construction Agencies will be empanelled in terms of eligibility criteria for laying / replacement of any type of sports surfaces and related Civil / Electrical works at any location in India .
- 4.2 For award of work, the financial bids will be invited through limited tenders from the empanelled agencies in due course of time

5.0 Eligibility Criteria

- 5.1 The Construction Agencies should have at least three years' experience in laying/ replacement of sports surfaces and other related Civil/ Electrical works and should have knowledge of International practices and guidelines (List of works pertaining to laying / replacement of Sports Surfaces more than 1 Crore to be submitted with completion cost, date of start/completion and the client)
- 5.2 Construction Agencies should have executed at least five works of laying/ replacement of sports surfaces and other related misc Civil/ Electrical works of more than Rs. 02 Crore each during the last three preceding years (Satisfactory completion certificate issued by an officer not below the rank of Section officer to be submitted)

- **5.3** The bidders should have an average annual turnover of Rs 10 Cr during the last three preceding years (Certificate from CA to be submitted)
- 5.4 The bidders should be solvent. Recent certificate (not less than one month old) to be enclosed from the banker
- 5.5 The bidders should not be debarred/blacklisted by any Govt/PSU/Autonomous body/any Registered body (Self undertaking to be submitted)

5.6 SELECTION PROCESS FOR EMPANELMENT

- 5.6.1 Construction Agencies shortlisted on the basis of eligibility criteria will be evaluated as per parameters given below; only those firms who secure 60 marks out of 100 will qualify for empanelment:
 - 1) Experience in laying/ replacement of sports surfaces and other related Civil/ Electrical works works (30 marks)

a)	3 to 5 years -	20 marks.
b)	5 to 10 years -	25 marks
C)	> 10 years -	30 marks

2) No of works (pertaining to sports surfaces) completed satisfactorily- >1 cr (25 marks) in last 3 years

3) Annual Turnover (Average of last three years) (20 Marks);

- a) 10 to 25 Crore 15 marks
- b) > 25 Crore 20 marks

4 Presentation ; (25 marks)

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Presentation should cover

- a) Quality assurance and quality control measures,
- b) Knowledge of international sports surfaces guidelines
- c) Approach and methodology for execution of assigned work
- d) Pictorial presentation on completed major sports surfaces works
- e) Any other information
