THIS MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING IS MADE BETWEEN:

THE FACULTY OF KINESIOLOGY UNIVERSITY OF ZAGREB ("UoZ") and
SPORTS AUTHORITY OF INDIA, Jawaharlal Nehru Stadium Complex (East Gate), Lodhi Road, New Delhi - 110003 ("SAI")

1. Introduction

- 1.1.1 UoZ and SAI wish to enter into a co-operative relationship for the general purpose of promoting teaching, research and other collaborative activity for the mutual benefit of both parties in Kinesiology.
- 1.2 This Memorandum of Understanding ("MoU") sets out below the principles by which UoZ and SAI can establish a formal arrangement regarding such activity.

2. Principles

- 2.1 UoZ and SAI propose the following in the field of Kinesiology :
 - 2.1.1 To identify and develop mutually-beneficial educational opportunities and enhancement activities including programme support and development; Distance Learning; flying faculty delivery and other engagements as appropriate. Consideration of consultancy opportunities for supporting development of high performance activities at SAI, further develop the 'training the trainers' visits to UoZ in the future.
These opportunities and activities will be focused on the development of Indian sports scientists, coaches and other groups as required to support the performance of the mission of the SAI through curriculum development and strategies in the field of Kinesiology.
 - 2.1.2 To explore and develop research opportunities that may develop from the alignment of SAI and UoZ areas of excellence and expertise, with an interest in attracting both national and international funding to support this research.
 - 2.1.3 To work together with the aim of developing sports policy with the potential to improve participation in sport and health in India and in other countries.

2.2. Any activity carried out within the broad framework of this MoU shall be subject to the mutual consent of both parties, taking into account any constraints of time, funding and other relevant resources.

2.2.1 Any developments undertaken to be within the broad framework agreement that covers the period of this MoU.

3. Subsidiary Agreements

In addition, it is envisaged that each activity that the parties wish to pursue in accordance with the purpose of this MoU will be governed by terms and conditions to be separately negotiated and mutually agreed upon by the parties through the signing of one or more subsidiary agreements.

4. Renewal Amendment and Termination

4.1 This MoU shall be effective for an initial period of five years(from the date of signing of MoU) Thereafter, this MoU may be extended for a further period of time as deemed appropriate by both parties, subject to their mutual consent and any such extension to be made in writing and signed by their authorised signatories.

4.2 Either party may amend this MoU at any time, provided it is with the prior written consent of both parties.

4.3 Either party may terminate this MoU at any time by giving three months' notice to the other party in writing.

5. General

5.1 The parties to this MoU shall not be deemed to be in breach of this understanding or otherwise liable to any other party in any manner whatsoever for any failure or delay in performing or initiating the activities proposed in this MoU.


5.2 Neither party shall be permitted to use the other's name, crest, logo or branding without first having obtained the other's written consent to such use and fully complying with the user guidelines and both parties shall immediately cease use of such name, crest, logo or branding upon termination or expiry of this MoU.

5.3 Any dispute arising from the interpretation or implementation of this MoU, shall be settled amicably through consultation or negotiation between the parties.


5.4 This MoU records the understanding between the parties and is not intended to be a legally binding document and shall not be enforceable in any Court of Law.
