CIRCULAR

Establishment of Physiotherapy facility is a vital part of any athlete training centre and has benefits ranging from injury assessment, treatment and rehabilitation. Acknowledging theimportance of Physiotherapy in the development of an athlete, the procurement for physiotherapy equipment was initiated for 09 remaining NCOEs (mentioned below) in a way similar to the pattern adopted in 13NCOEs.

In this regard, the equipment procurement being undertaken from SAI H.O along with its statusis given below in Table I:

Apart from the equipment listed above, the RDs can procureadditional physiotherapy equipment to cater to the dynamic requirement at each NCOE, subject to amaximum of Rs. 25 lakhs.

The common guidelines to be followed by such 09 NCOE centres while undertaking the procurement within the allotted grant of Rs. 25 lakhsare as follows:

• Only physiotherapy equipment are to be bought.

• In case there is an additional requirement within Table I (in terms of quantity), such equipment should be procured after doing proper gap analysis and in line with exemption received from the MYAS. (attached for reference).

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• In case of critical items, PAC procurement may be done. However, such PAC items should be procured in compliance with all the guidelines circulated vide SAI H.O Circular dated 03.06.2021.

Any procurement mentioned above is to be undertaken in complian1ce with GFR 2017, procurement manual and all recent guidelines including DPIIT order dated 16.09.2020 & 04.03.2021 regarding preference to Make in India (except for case of items exempted by MYAS).

It is directed to initiate the procurement for identified physiotherapy equipment at each centre as per above guidelines, within delegated powers for procurement of Sports Equipment and Sports Science Equipment vide Office Order No. 88/2019 dated 12.12.2019 and further clarifications issued by Finance Division.
