SUB: Standard Operating Procedure (SOP) for Providing Access to Non-Residential Khelo India Athletes (KIAs) to Services Offered in National Centres of Excellence (NCoE)

- Introduction The Standard Operating Procedure (SOP) outlined below is established to ensure a
 structured and transparent process for granting access to non-residential Khelo India Athletes
 (KIAs) to a wide range of services offered within the National Centres of Excellence (NCoE). These
 services encompass accommodation, sports science facilities, expert counselling sessions,
 rehabilitation and injury management, and access to sports training facilities. The SOP aims to
 facilitate the development and growth of KIAs by providing them with essential resources and
 support at NCoEs.
- Purpose The purpose of this SOP is to define the systematic procedure for KIAs to access and
 utilize services available at NCoEs. It ensures that eligible athletes have equitable access to the
 services they require for their athletic development, recovery, and performance enhancement.
- Scope This SOP applies to all NCoEs under the purview of the Sports Authority of India (SAI) and KIAs recognized under Khelo India scheme. It encompasses the following services but is not limited to:
 - Boarding and lodging during availing of services at NCOE
 - Sports science facilities
 - Expert counselling sessions
 - Rehabilitation and injury management
 - Sports training facilities

4. Definitions

- NCoE: National Centre of Excellence, a specialized facility under SAI dedicated to the training and development of elite athletes.
- KIA: Khelo India Athlete, a talented athlete identified under the Khelo India program.

5. Process Flow

5.1. Request Submission

1. KIAs or their coaches initiate the request for access to NCoE services atleast 15 days before the planned date of arrival to NCOE.

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- The request should specify the NCoE they wish to access and the specific services required.
 NCOE wise sports disciplines covered is elaborated in Annexure A
- The athlete or coach submits the request over NCoE's official e-mail to the respective NCoE's Sports Officer.
- Accommodation, training slots, counselling sessions, or other services are booked through filling a standardized request form proforma (Annexure B) provided by the NCoE and sending it over email.
- This proforma involves providing personal information, medical history (if required), and confirming the dates of stay.

5.2. Evaluation and Approval

- The Khelo India nodal officer at NCoE reviews the request and consults with relevant experts within the NCoE to assess the feasibility of the request.
- Factors considered during the evaluation include the athlete's training plan, medical records (if applicable), and resource availability.
- Based on the evaluation, the officer sends the request to Regional Director who decides to approve or deny the request.

5.3. Communication of Approval

- If the request is approved by the Regional Director, the Khelo India nodal officer at NcoE
 communicates the approval to the athlete or their coach.
- 2. Communication includes:
 - Confirmation of approved services.
 - Duration of access.
 - Any specific rules or guidelines to be followed during the stay.
- 3. Athletes are provided with contact information for the NCoE's coordinator, who assists with logistics.

5.4. Access and Utilization

- 1. Athletes access the approved services and facilities as per their confirmed booking.
- They must adhere to the NCoE's rules and guidelines, including training schedules and behavioral expectations.
- 3. The booking shall be extended by the concerned officer after monitoring the progress.

5.5. Progress Monitoring

- The Khelo India nodal officer at NCoE along with relevant sports science experts monitor the athlete's progress and service utilization throughout their stay.
- Progress reports and feedback sessions may be scheduled to assess the effectiveness of the services provided.

5.6. Termination of Access

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- Access to NCoE services may be terminated if athletes fail to comply with the NCoE's rules
 or if their scheduled stay is marked complete by the concerned NCoE officer.
- 2. Athletes will be formally notified in writing of access termination, with reasons provided.

5.7. Feedback and Review

- Athletes may be requested to provide feedback on their NCoE experience to help improve services.
- 2. The SOP is periodically reviewed and updated to ensure its effectiveness and relevance.

6. Responsibilities

- KIAs and their coaches: Responsible for initiating requests and complying with NCoE rules.
- Khelo India nodal officer at NCoE: Responsible for evaluating requests, coordinating access, and monitoring progress.
- Regional Director: Responsible for approving the admission request
- NCoE Sports Science Experts: Responsible for providing requested services and monitoring athlete progress.
- SAI: Responsible for recognizing eligible KIAs and overseeing the implementation of this SOP.

7. Fund support

- 7.1. Khelo India Athletes can use their stipend amount towards bearing the complete expenses for transportation to and from NCoE
- 7.2. Expenses other than Athlete transportation will be borne by the respective NCoE
- 7.3. NCoE will prepare the estimate expenditure incurred for each Athlete based on the services availed and will be reimbursed as per actuals from their SAI Regional Centres on a quarterly basis. SAI Regional Centres will consolidate the entire expense report for NCOEs under their jurisdiction and send the request to SAI HO for reimbursement under Khelo India scheme.
- 7.4. Fund utilisation will be periodically reviewed to ensure its effectiveness and relevance.
