

Bid Corrigendum

Following terms and conditions supersede all existing "Buyer added Bid Specific Terms and conditions" given in the bid document or any previous corrigendum. Prospective bidders are advised to bid as per following Terms and Conditions:

Buyer Added Bid Specific Additional Terms and Conditions

1. **OPTION CLAUSE 25% :** The buyer can increase or decrease the contract quantity or contract duration up to 25 percent at the time of issue of the contract. However, once the contract is issued, the contract quantity or contract duration can only be increased up to 25 percent. Bidders are bound to accept the revised quantity or duration.
For lumpsum-based service contracts, the buyer may increase the scope of work and contract value up to 25 percent with the consent of the service provider
2. **AVAILABILITY OF OFFICE OF SERVICE PROVIDER:** An office of the Service Provider must be located in the state of Consignee. **DOCUMENTARY EVIDENCE TO BE SUBMITTED.**
3. Bidders can also submit the EMD with Account Payee Demand Draft in favour of Regional Director, Sports Authority of India, NSRC Lucknow payable at Lucknow
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Bidder has to upload scanned copy / proof of the DD along with bid and has to ensure delivery of hardcopy to the Buyer within 5 days of Bid End date / Bid Opening date.
4. Bidders can also submit the EMD with Fixed Deposit Receipt made out or pledged in the name of A/C Regional Director, Sports Authority of India, NS Regional Centre
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The bank should certify on it that the deposit can be withdrawn only on the demand or with the sanction of the pledgee. For release of EMD, the FDR will be released in the favour of the bidder by the Buyer after making endorsement on the back of the FDR duly signed and stamped along with covering letter. Bidder has to upload scanned copy/ proof of the FDR along with bid and has to ensure delivery of hardcopy to the Buyer within 5 days of Bid End date/ Bid Opening date
5. **Bidder financial standing:** The bidder should not be under liquidation, court receivership or similar proceedings, should not be bankrupt. Bidder to upload undertaking to this effect with bid.
6. **Proof for Past Experience and Project Experience clause:** For fulfilling the experience criteria any one of the following documents may be considered as valid proof for meeting the experience criteria:a. Contract copy along with Invoice(s) with self-certification by the bidder that service/supplies against the invoices have been executed.b. Execution certificate by client with contract value.c. Any other document in support of contract execution like Third Party Inspection release note, etc.
Proof for Past Experience and Project Experience clause: For fulfilling the experience criteria any one of the following documents may be considered as valid proof for meeting the experience criteria:a. Contract copy along with Invoice(s) with self-certification by the bidder that service/supplies against the invoices have been executed.b. Execution certificate by client with contract value.c. Any other document in support of contract execution like Third Party Inspection release note, etc.
7. Successful Bidder can submit the Performance Security in the form of Account Payee Demand Draft also (besides PBG which is allowed as per GeM GTC). DD should be made in favour of Regional Director, Sports Authority of India, NSRC Lucknow payable at Lucknow
.
After award of contract, Successful Bidder can upload scanned copy of the DD in place of PBG and has to ensure delivery of hard copy to the original DD to the Buyer within 15 days of award of contract.
8. Successful Bidder can submit the Performance Security in the form of Fixed Deposit Receipt also (besides PBG which is allowed as per GeM GTC). FDR should be made out or pledged in the name of

Regional Director, Sports Authority of India, NS Regional Centre
A/C (Name of the Seller). The bank should certify on it that the deposit can be withdrawn only on the demand or with the sanction of the pledgee. For release of Security Deposit, the FDR will be released in favour of bidder by the Buyer after making endorsement on the back of the FDR duly signed and stamped along with covering letter. Successful Bidder has to upload scanned copy of the FDR document in place of PBG and has to ensure delivery of hard copy of Original FDR to the Buyer within 15 days of award of contract.

9. Buyer Added text based ATC clauses

As per the list of items the bidder is requested to submit the **rate per KG and per PCs/Ltr./Pkt./Btl. and also submit the rate of total qty. (as per applicability) mentioned in BOQ.** The total value of the final estimated quantity given need to be filled as a lump sum amount by the bidder. The total quantity of the items as mentioned in the list can be increased or decreased depending on total campers. The bidders are also required to submit the UP State FSSAI License or All India Central FSSAI License (if applicable) in relevant field for supply of Fruit and Vegetable items. The bidder is required to submit the MSME Certificate in relevant field or 3% EMD of the total value of the contract related to supply of Fruit and Vegetable items. Price quoted should be inclusive of taxes, delivery, unloading etc.

The fruits and vegetables supplied shall be:

- Fresh and hygienic
- Free from decay, infestation and worms
- Free from artificial colouring agents, wax and harmful chemicals
- Uniform in quality and maturity
- Free from mud, stones and foreign matter
- Suitable for consumption by athletes

During execution of the contract, the SAI reserves the right to increase or decrease, the quantity of items mentioned in the "Price Schedule/Scope of Work" up to Twenty Five per cent (rounded off to next whole number) without any change in the unit price and other terms & conditions quoted in the bid by the bidder.

Clerical errors, if any, are liable to be rectified whenever noticed.

1. Tender form shall be completed in all respect. Incomplete tenders shall be treated as invalid.
2. Bidders have to ensure that all the documents are properly uploaded and are readable format.
3. The Competent Authority reserves the right to accept or reject (fully or partially) any tender or all tender without assigning any reason.

The contract for Supply of Fruits and Vegetables Items shall be awarded to the bidder with lowest quotation in grand total value (per kg rate total) of financial bid.

At any time prior to the deadline for submission of bids, the Buyer reserves the right to modify, amend, or correct any errors, omissions, or discrepancies in this Tender Document. Any such modification will be formalized through the issuance of a Corrigendum/Addendum, which will be published on Sports Authority of India website and shall be binding on all bidders. The Buyer assumes no responsibility for a bidder's failure to note such amendments.

The Buyer has taken reasonable care in preparing this tender document. However, any typographical, clerical, or minor administrative errors or omissions found within the specifications, terms, or associated documents shall be subject to correction by the Buyer without creating any legal liability or invalidating the tender process. In the event of an obvious discrepancy, the Buyer's interpretation and subsequent correction shall prevail.

The Buyer reserves the right to waive any minor informality, non-conformity, or irregularity

in a bid that does not constitute a material deviation, provided such waiver does not prejudice or affect the relative ranking of any bidder.

CORRIGENDUM:

1. Revised Eligibility Criteria for MSEs & Startups :-

1. If the bidder is a Micro or Small Enterprise as per latest orders issued by Ministry of MSME, the bidder shall be relaxed from the eligibility criteria of "Experience Criteria" as defined above subject to meeting of quality and technical specifications. The bidder seeking Relaxation from Experience Criteria, shall upload the supporting documents to prove his eligibility for Relaxation.

2. If the bidder is a Micro or Small Enterprise (MSE) as per latest orders issued by Ministry of MSME, the bidder shall be relaxed from the eligibility criteria of "Bidder Turnover" as defined above subject to meeting of quality and technical specifications. If the bidder itself is MSE OEM of the offered products, it would be relaxed from the "OEM Average Turnover" criteria also subject to meeting of quality and technical specifications. The bidder seeking Relaxation from Turnover, shall upload the supporting documents to prove his eligibility for Relaxation.

3. If the bidder is a DPIIT registered Startup, the bidder shall be relaxed from the eligibility criteria of "Experience Criteria" as defined above subject to their meeting of quality and technical specifications. The bidder seeking Relaxation from Experience Criteria, shall upload the supporting documents to prove his eligibility for Relaxation.

4. If the bidder is a DPIIT registered Startup, the bidder shall be relaxed from the eligibility criteria of "Bidder Turnover" as defined above subject to their meeting of quality and technical specifications. If the bidder is DPIIT Registered O

EM of the offered products, it would be relaxed from the "OEM Average Turnover" criteria also subject to meeting of quality and technical specifications. The bidder seeking Relaxation from Turnover shall upload the supporting documents to prove his eligibility for Relaxation.

5. The minimum average annual financial turnover of the bidder during the last three years, ending on 31st March of the previous financial year, should be as indicated above in the bid document. Documentary evidence in the form of certified Audited Balance Sheets of relevant periods or a certificate from the Chartered Accountant/Cost Accountant indicating the turnover details for the relevant period shall be uploaded with the bid. In case the date of constitution / incorporation of the bidder is less than 3-year-old, the average turnover in respect of the completed financial years after the date of constitution shall be taken into account for this criteria.

6. It is hereby clarified that partial relaxation from the requirements of prior years of experience and average annual turnover is extended to all eligible Micro and Small Enterprises (MSEs) as per latest orders issued by Ministry of MSME, and DPIIT-recognized and registered Startups, in accordance with the applicable Government of India procurement policies and GeM provisions. However, they must comply with all other eligibility conditions, technical specifications, quality requirements, and contractual obligations stipulated in the bid document.

Disclaimer

The Additional Terms and Conditions (ATC) have been incorporated by the Buyer after approval of their Competent Authority. The Buyer is solely responsible for the impact of these clauses on the bidding process, its outcome, and consequences thereof including any restriction arising in the bidding process due to these ATCs and including the modification of technical specifications and / or terms and conditions governing the bid. All representations / grievances pertaining to the ATC clauses shall be raised with the buyer organization directly and not with GeM. If any of the clause(s) is/are incorporated by the Buyer regarding the following, the bid & resultant contract shall be treated as null & void. Further, GeM reserves the right, at its sole discretion, to cancel the bid forthwith, without issuance of any prior notice or intimation :-

1. Publishing Custom / BOQ bids for items for which regular GeM categories are available (unless such Custom / BOQ item is bunched with the major regular product Category Item).
2. Mandating procurement of / from specific Brand / Make / Model / Manufacturer / Dealer except in case of Single Bid / Proprietary Article Certificate (PAC) Buying.
3. Inclusion of disqualification criteria related to suspension of seller / service provider, where such suspension period has already expired.
4. Mandating submission of documents in physical form as a pre-requisite to qualify bidders.
5. Publishing bids on GeM for procurement of works.
6. Procurement of Goods by creating a Service bid on GeM & vice-versa.
7. Seeking sample with bid or approval of samples during bid evaluation process. However, trial / sample, as the case may be, shall be permitted in cases where trial / sample are allowed as per approved and published procurement policy of the Buyers' controlling Ministry / Department / State / Public Sector Enterprises Headquarters. If there is any violation of trial / sample clause with regard to approved policy of the Buyers' Ministry / Department / State / Public Sector Enterprises Headquarters, then this is to be determined and redressed by the concerned Buyer Organisation only.
8. Seeking experience from specific organization / department / institute only or from foreign / export experience.

9. Creating bid for items from incorrect categories.
10. Reference of conditions published on any external site or reference to external documents/clauses.
11. Asking for any Tender fee / Bid Participation fee, as the case may be.
12. Buyer added ATC Clauses which are in contravention of clauses defined in bid detail section, including specifications, EMD Detail, ePBG Detail and MII and MSE Purchase Preference sections of the bid, unless otherwise allowed by the applicable GeM GTC.
13. Any ATC clause in contravention with GeM GTC Clause 4 (xiii) (h) will be invalid. In case of multiple L1 bidders against a service bid, the buyer shall place the Contract by selection of a bidder amongst the L-1 bidders through a Random Algorithm executed by GeM system.
14. In a category based bid, adding additional items, through buyer added, additional scope of work/ additional terms and conditions/or any other document. If buyer needs more items along with the main item, the same must be added through bunching category based items or by bunching custom catalogues or bunching a BoQ with the main category based item, the same must not be done through ATC or Scope of Work.

Further, if any seller has any objection/grievance against these additional clauses or otherwise on any aspect of this bid, they can raise their representation against the same by using the Representation window provided in the bid details field in Seller dashboard after logging in as a seller. Buyer is duty bound to reply to all such representations and would not be allowed to open bids if he fails to reply to such representations.
