3. The Committee was apprised of the queries submitted by the bidders. The queries and respective replies to the queries are tabulated here as under:

Name of Company: M/s SAGAR INTERNATIONAL

S. No.	Query	Clarification
1	CVC instructions clearly dictates that the practice to take the samples with bid must be avoided to maintain the spirit of tender since the bonafide & reasonable bids are normally rejected on the name of 'feel & finish' by manual process. Advance Sample should be taken before commencing the supply after placing supply order to the lowest one. Notably last year this practice was also followed by your office but this year under which circumstances it has been neglected nothing has been assigned.	The reference has been taken from the RFP floated by Ministry of Defence to ensure the requisite quality (reference RFP document no. A/26979/CP Cell/OS-PIII/UN MSN/Sports Shoes/RC/Re-t).
2	As per directions of Ministry of Micro, Small & Medium Enterprises issued vide Circular No. 1 (2)(1)/2016-MA dated 10th March, 2016 all MSME units " must " be relaxed with prior turnover and prior experience.	As per the circular of said Ministry, the conditions " may " be relaxed regarding the prior turnover and experience. However, given the event is of National importance, to ensure the timely delivery, the capability of the successful bidder needs to be ensured. In this regard, the decision of Competent Authority shall be final.
3	It has been defined in the tender that the order of all items will be placed to one bidder only. In this regard it is submitted that there are number of different items to be purchased and the process of lab testing shall also be followed before placing supply order. Practically it would be quite difficult that all items of one bidder get clearance in lab testing and in case of failure of one or two items in lab testing, the tendering authority would have no other option except to scrap the entire tender or to compromise with the inferior quality. Therefore it would be a prudent act if item wise order is placed to the lowest bidder subject to clearance of lab testing.	No clarification required. No change in the RFP.
4	Moreover placing the entire order to one bidder shall also cause monetary loss to government exchequer whereas on other hand placing of item wise supply order to the lowest bidder shall save government money. It is not virtually possible that one bidder shall be able to offer lowest price of each item.	No clarification required. No change in the RFP.
5	Placing of entire order to one bidder may also put the tendering authority in embarrassing position in case the bidder remain fails to supply the material. In that	No clarification required. No change in the RFP.

	the event of placing item wise supply order, only specific item shall be held-up if the bidder unfortunately remain fails to supply and arrangement of substitute thereof would be comparatively easy.

1	You have to get our sample tested from NABL test lab. Then there is no point that you are asking for our product's test reports too as we will be spending money & time unnecessary.	It is clarified that in place of lab reports, the bidder may submit self-certification of compliance to the specifications in respect of each item stated in the RFP.
2	There are so many common cloths for which we made the group. The required report should be allowed in groups when quality cloth in common.	The testing shall be done for individual garment as specified in the RFP.
3	The track suit weight given by you (400-450 gms, tolerance +-5%) is not possible, as its almost impossible to produce such a thin track suit.	It is clarified that the overall weight of the garment in all categories shall not be considered for the purpose of technical evaluation.
4	Archery and Shooting twill pants should have lycra in it. Otherwise it can't be used in sports.	No clarification required. No change in the RFP.
5	Athletics Woven Shorts (with lining) – now a days woven shorts are out of fashion. Any stretchable cloth should be asked.	It is clarified that the material and fabric mentioned in Cycling Kit shall be used for Athletics shorts.
6	Kit bag size has not been given	It is clarified that the size of Kit bag in L X H X W shall be 28" X 14" X 12" with wheels.
7	The tender authority has given the date of supply of 75% goods on 20 th December 2019 and 25% on 1 st January 2020 but order placement date is not mentioned.	The work order shall be released after finalisation of L1 bidder.
8	The date of submission may be delayed by one week because of heavy rush of orders & Diwali festival.	No clarification required. No change in the RFP.

General Queries:

S. No.	Query	Clarification
1	If it is mandatory to quote for all the items in BOQ.	Yes. If the bidder does not quote for all the items, their bid will be treated as non-responsive and shall be rejected.
2	If packing material for the articles need to be plastic?	As per the recent developments, usage of single use plastic is discouraged. Therefore, the articles are not to be packed in single use plastic.
3	If a bidder has failed the prequalification criteria, will he get the testing fee returned?	It is clarified that due to limited time at hand, the sample garment items shall be

		sent for testing as soon as they are submitted to SAI on case to case basis. Therefore, the fee shall not be refunded in any case.
4	In qualification criteria, mention of Clause 14 in Section II (A) is there, however it is deleted.	It is clarified that the clause 14 may be read as clause 7 of section II (A).
