Notification for Appointment of Foreign Coach / Expert

The Table Tennis Federation of India (TTFI), the apex governing body for the sport of Table Tennis in the country, is inviting applications from eligible and qualified international candidates for the post of **Foreign Coach / Expert** – Table Tennis.

TTFI is committed to integrating global best practices into the Indian sporting ecosystem. This role is designed for an international expert capable of elevating India's performance at major international competitions, including the Asian Games 2026 and the Olympic Games 2028. The position plays a critical role in the technical delivery of elite athlete programs and the systematic upgrading of the national coaching workforce.

Objective of the Role

The Foreign Coach / Expert will be responsible for:

- Directly coaching and managing the preparation of the Senior National Team for podium outcomes;
- Delivering scientifically informed and data-driven technical strategies tailored to the modern international game;
- Identifying and bridging technical gaps in the Indian pathway from junior to senior elite levels.

Roles and Expectations

The Foreign Expert will be expected to:

- Enhance the tactical and technical proficiency of individual players through individualized periodization and high-intensity training modules;
- Promote international methods for recovery, injury prevention, and mental toughness in high-pressure match scenarios;
- Maintain close coordination with the High Performance Director to ensure alignment with national goals.

Key Responsibilities

- Define and manage international-standard training benchmarks and elite performance indicators;
- Provide technical leadership to integrated support teams, focusing on the application of performance analytics in match-play;
- Drive long-term athlete development (LTAD) and manage the "Junior-to-Senior" transition with a focus on global competitiveness;
- Monitor and report on the trajectory of elite athletes using modern performance data management systems;
- Maintain readiness for the congested international professional circuit and major multi-sport events.

Essential Qualifications

- Minimum 7 years of experience coaching at the elite international level, with a focus on Olympic or World Championship preparation.
- A proven track record of producing medal-winning athletes at the Continental, World, or Olympic level (names of athletes must be detailed in the CV).
- Demonstrated experience in mentoring national-level coaches and designing coach education programs.
- Deep understanding of the technical, tactical, and physical demands of the "Top 20" international table tennis landscape.
- Excellent command of the English language; ability to prepare strategic reports and technical presentations.
- Ability to demonstrate high-level technical skills and techniques to athletes during training sessions.

Tenure and Review

The appointment will be for up to the 2028 Olympic Games, with performance subject to annual evaluations and a comprehensive review after one year.

Remuneration

The remuneration for this position will be commensurate with international standards, qualifications, and experience.

Reporting Authority

The Foreign Coach / Expert will report to the High Performance Director and to the Table Tennis Federation of India.
