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SECTION – II
INSTRUCTIONS TO BIDDERS (ITB)

A. PREAMBLE

1. Introduction:

The Purchaser has issued these Bidding Documents for purchase of goods and related services as mentioned in Section – V – “Schedule of Requirements”, which also indicates, *interalia*, the required delivery schedule, terms and place of delivery.

This section (Section II - “Instruction to Bidders”) provides the relevant information as well as instructions to assist the prospective Bidders in preparation and submission of Bids. It also includes the mode and procedure to be adopted by the Purchaser for receipt and opening as well as scrutiny and evaluation of Bids and subsequent placement of contract.

Before formulating the Bid and submitting the same to the Purchaser, the Bidder should read and examine all the terms, conditions, instructions etc. contained in the Bidding Documents. Failure to provide and/or comply with the required information, instructions etc. incorporated in these Bidding Documents may result in rejection of its Bid.

2. Language of Bid:

The Bid submitted by the Bidder and all subsequent correspondence and documents relating to the Bid exchanged between the Bidder and the Purchaser, shall be written in the English language. However, the language of any printed literature furnished by the Bidder in connection with its Bid may be written in any other language provided the same is accompanied by an English translation and, for purposes of interpretation of the Bid, the English translation shall prevail.

B. BIDDING DOCUMENTS

3. Content of Bidding Documents:

In addition to Section I – “Invitation for Bid” (IFB), the Bidding Documents include:

- Section IV – Bid submission Form
- Section IV B -- Price Schedule
- Section IV C -- Bank Guarantee form for Bid security
- Section IV E -- NEFT Mandate form
- Section V – Schedule of Requirements (SOR)
- Section V I – Technical Specifications
- Section VII – General Conditions of Contract (GCC)
- Section VIII – Contract Forms
- Section VIII-B -- Bank Guarantee form for performance security

4. Amendments to Bidding Documents:

At any time prior to the deadline for submission of Bids, the Purchaser may, for any reason deemed fit by it, modify the Bidding Documents by issuing suitable amendment(s) to it.

5. Clarification of Bidding Documents:

A Bidder requiring any clarification or elucidation on any issue of the Bidding Documents may take up the same with the Purchaser in writing.

C. PREPARATION OF BIDS**6. Documents Comprising the Bid:**

The "Bid" prepared by the Bidder shall comprise the following:

- i) Bid Submission Form as per Section IV (A).
- ii) Power of Attorney in favour of signatory of Bidding Documents
- iii) The technical specification of quoted goods alongwith relevant documents like technical data, literature, drawing etc./ undertaking regarding complaints to tender requirement.
- iv) Performance Statement as per Form in Section III.
- v) The GST number/TAN number & PAN number may be given with the quotation, otherwise Quotation will be rejected.
- vi) National Electronic Fund transfer (NEFT) Form as per Section IV (E) for payment in Indian Rupee, if applicable.
- vii) Price Schedule(s) as per Forms I for goods in Section-IV(B) filled up with all the details.
- viii) The successful firm will have to provide credit facility minimum for the one moth to SAI (undertaking).
- ix) The bidding firm should be an authorized license/registration supplier of petrol/diesel Pol etc of PSU Brands such as Indian Oil/Hindustan Petrol & Bharat Petroleum etc.

It is the responsibility of Bidder to go through the Bidding Document to ensure furnishing of all required documents in addition to above, if any.

All pages of the Bid should be page numbered and indexed.

The authorized signatory of the Bidder must sign the Bid duly stamped at appropriate places and initial all the remaining pages of the Bid.

A Bidder, who does not fulfil any of the above requirements and/or gives evasive information/reply against any such requirement, shall be liable to be ignored and rejected.

Bid sent by e-mail/fax/telex/cable/electronically shall be ignored and rejected.

All payments in Indian Rupee will be made through National Electronic Fund Transfer (NEFT)/RTGS System. Bidders are required to fill and attach the NEFT Mandate Form attached as per Section-IV (E) alongwith their offers, if not already executed in SAI. Notification of Award will not be issued without NEFT Mandate Form.

7. Bid Currencies:

The Bidder supplying goods/items as specified in secluded V shall quote in Indian Rupees Only.

8 Bid Prices:

The Bidder shall indicate on the Price Schedule provided under Section IV (B) all the specified components of prices shown therein. All the columns shown in the price schedule should be filled up as required. If any column does not apply to a Bidder, same should be clarified as "NA" (means Not Applicable) by the Bidder.

Additional information and instruction on Duties and Taxes:

If the Bidder desires to ask for Excise Duty, GST/ CENVAT, Custom Duty, Service Tax, Works Contract Tax etc. to be paid extra, the same must be specifically stated. In the absence of any such stipulation the price will be taken inclusive of such duties and taxes and no claim for the same will be entertained later. Only statutory variations on finished product taking place after Bid submission shall be allowed to the extent of actual quantum paid by the supplier.

Octroi Duty and Local Duties & Taxes:

Normally, goods to be supplied to government departments against government contracts are exempted from levy of town duty, Octroi duty, terminal tax and other levies of local bodies. However, on some occasions, the local bodies (like town body, municipal body etc.) as per their regulations allow such exemptions only on production of certificate to this effect from the concerned government department. Keeping this in view, the supplier shall ensure that the stores to be supplied by the supplier against the contract placed by the Purchaser are exempted from levy of any such duty or tax and, wherever necessary, obtain the exemption certificate from the Purchaser.

However, if a local body still insists upon payment of such local duties and taxes, the same should be paid by the supplier to the local body to avoid delay in supplies and possible demurrage charges and obtain a receipt for the same. The supplier should forward the receipt obtained for such payment to the Purchaser to enable the Purchaser reimburse the supplier and take other necessary action in the matter.

The need for indication of all such price components by the Bidders, as required in this clause (viz., ITB clause 8) is for the purpose of comparison of the Bids by the Purchaser and will no way restrict the Purchaser's right to award the contract on the selected Bidder on any of the terms offered.

9. Firm Price:

The prices quoted by the Bidder shall remain firm and fixed during the currency of the contract and not subject to variation on any account.

However, as regards taxes and duties, if any, chargeable on the goods and payable, the conditions stipulated in ITB Clause 8 will apply.

10. Alternative Bids:

Alternative Bids which are not meeting the Bid specifications, are not permitted and will be rejected.

11. Documents Establishing Bidder's Eligibility and Qualifications:

Pursuant to ITB clause 6, the Bidder shall furnish, as part of its Bid, relevant details and documents establishing its qualifications to perform the contract if its Bid is accepted.

The documentary evidence needed to establish the Bidder's qualifications shall fulfil the following requirements:

The Bidder and manufacturer meets the qualification criteria incorporated in the Section III.

12. Bid Security:

Bid Security/Earnest Money Deposit (EMD) is replaced with Bid Securing declaration as per Ministry of Finance, Department of Expenditure O.M. dated 12th November, 2020.

All bidders are required to upload along with the technical bid, a duly signed and sealed copy of Bid Securing declaration as per Section IV (C).

13. Bid Validity:

The Bid shall remain valid for acceptance for a period of 90 days (Ninety days) after the date of Bid opening prescribed in the Bidding Document. Any Bid valid for a shorter period shall be treated as unresponsive and rejected.

In exceptional cases, the Bidders may be requested by the Purchaser to extend the validity of their Bids up to a specified period. The Bidders, who agree to extend the Bid validity, are to extend the same without any change or modification of their original Bid and they are also to extend the validity period of the Bid Security accordingly. A Bidder, however, may not agree to extend its Bid validity without forfeiting its Bid Security.

In case the day up to which the Bids are to remain valid falls on or subsequently declared a holiday or closed day for the Purchaser, the Bid validity shall automatically be extended up to the next working day.

14. Signing and Sealing of Bid:

The Bidders shall submit their Bids as per the instructions contained in ITB Clause 6.

Bid shall either be typed or written in indelible ink and the same shall be signed by the Bidder or by a person(s) who has been duly authorized to bind the Bidder to the contract.

The Bid shall be duly signed at the appropriate places as indicated in the Bidding Documents and all other pages of the Bid. The Bid shall not contain any erasure or overwriting, except as necessary to correct any error made by the Bidder and, if there is any such correction; the person signing the Bid shall initial the same. The letter of authorization shall be by a written power of attorney, which shall also be furnished along with the Bid.

Bidding Document seeks quotation following **Two Bid Systems**. The Bid should be submitted in a sealed cover mentioning Bid Ref. no. & date of Opening.

Technical and price bid are to be submitted separately with in the time & date mention in the bid document.

D. SUBMISSION OF BIDS

15. Submission of Bids:

The bids from the bidder should be in English and should consist of the documents stated below in Clause 6.1 and are to be submitted in password protected compressed folders at E-mail – gad-sai@gov.in / saigad1@yahoo.com on or before 18th June, 2021, 11:00 AM

16. Late Bid:

A Bid, which is received after the specified date and time for receipt of Bids will be treated as “Late” Bid and will be ignored.

E. BID OPENING

17. Opening of Bids:

The Purchaser will open the Bids at the specified date and time and at the specified place as indicated in the IFB in Section-I.

In case the specified date of Bid opening falls on or is subsequently declared a holiday or closed day for the Purchaser, the Bids will be opened at the appointed time and place on the next working day.

Authorized representatives of the Bidders, who have submitted Bids on time may attend the Bid opening provided they bring with them letters of authority from the corresponding Bidders.

F. SCRUTINY AND EVALUATION OF BIDS

18. Preliminary Scrutiny of Bids:

The Purchaser will examine the Bids to determine whether they are complete, whether the documents have been properly signed, stamped and whether the Bids are generally in order.

Prior to the detailed evaluation of Price Bids, the Purchaser will determine the substantial responsiveness of each Bid to the Bidding Document. For purposes of these clauses, a substantially responsive Bid is one, which conforms to all the terms and conditions of the Bidding Documents including Technical Specifications without material deviations. However minor deviation and /or minor irregularity and/or minor non-conformity in the Bid, the Purchaser may waive the same.

If a Bid is not substantially responsive, it will be rejected by the Purchaser.

19. Qualification Criteria:

Bids of the Bidders, who do not meet the required Qualification Criteria prescribed in Section III, will be treated as non - responsive and will not be considered further.

20. Comparison of Bids and Award Criteria:

For comparison for ranking purpose for evaluation, the comparison of the responsive Bids shall be carried out on consignee site basis.

The contract may be awarded to the overall lowest responsive Bidder who meets the laid down Qualification Criteria in the Bid documents.

G. AWARD OF CONTRACT**21. Purchaser's Right to accept any Bid and to reject any or all Bids:**

The Purchaser reserves the right to accept in part or in full any Bid or reject any or more Bid(s) without assigning any reason or to cancel the Bidding process and reject all Bids at any time prior to award of contract, without incurring any liability, whatsoever to the affected Bidder or Bidders.

22. Variation of Quantities at the Time of Award/ Currency of Contract:

At the time of awarding the contract or during the currency of the Contract, the Purchaser reserves the right to increase or decrease by up to twenty-five (25) per cent, the quantity of goods and services mentioned in the schedule (s) in the "Schedule of Requirements" (rounded off to next whole number) without any change in the rates and other terms & conditions quoted by the Bidder.

The contract will be for the period of **two year** from the date of award of contract, extendable for a further period of one year on the basis of satisfactory performance and on mutual agreement.

23. Notification of Award & issue of Contract:

Before expiry of the Bid validity period, the Purchaser will notify the successful Bidder(s) in writing, by registered / speed post or by fax/ email (to be confirmed by registered / speed post) that it's Bid for goods & services, which have been selected by the Purchaser, has been accepted. The successful Bidder must furnish to the Purchaser the required Performance Security immediately upon Notification of Award and Contract Agreement failing which the bid security will be forfeited and the award will be cancelled. Relevant details about the Performance Security have been provided under GCC Clause 3 under Section-VII.

The successful Bidder shall return the original copy of the contract, duly signed and dated, to the Purchaser immediately upon issue of contract.

The Purchaser reserves the right to issue the Notification of Award and Contract consignee wise and schedule wise.

24. Non-receipt of Performance Security and Contract by the Purchaser:

Failure of the successful Bidder in providing Performance Security and / or returning contract copy duly signed in terms of ITB Clauses-23 above shall make the Bidder liable for forfeiture of its bid security and, also, for further actions by the Purchaser against it as per the clause 16 of GCC – Termination of default in Section-VII.

25. Corrupt or Fraudulent Practices:

It is required by all concerned namely the Consignee/Bidders/Suppliers etc to observe the highest standard of ethics during the procurement and execution of such contracts. In pursuance of this policy, the Purchaser: -

- (a) will reject a proposal for award if it determines that the Bidder recommended for award has engaged in corrupt or fraudulent or collusion or coercive practices in competing for the contract in question;
- (b) will declare a firm ineligible or blacklist, either indefinitely or for a stated period of time, to be awarded a contract by the Purchaser if it at any time determines that the firm has engaged in corrupt or fraudulent or collusion or coercive practices in competing for, or in executing the contract.

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SECTION - VII

GENERAL CONDITIONS OF CONTRACT (GCC)

1. **Application:**
The General Conditions of Contract incorporated in this section shall be applicable for this purchase to the extent the same is not superseded by Schedule of Requirements under Section V and Technical Specification under Section VI of this document.
2. **Country of Origin:**
The word “origin” incorporated in this clause means the place from where the goods are manufactured, produced or processed.
3. **Performance Security:**
Immediately after Notification of Award and Contract Agreement by the Purchaser , the supplier, shall furnish performance security to the Purchaser for an amount equal to ten percent (3%) of the total value of the contract, valid up to sixty days after warranty period (01) year from satisfactory installation & acceptance) of the store by the consignee.
The Performance security shall be denominated in Indian Rupees in any one of the forms namely Account Payee Demand Draft or Fixed Deposit Receipt drawn from any Scheduled bank in India or Bank Guarantee issued by a Scheduled bank in India, in the prescribed form as provided in Section VIII (B) of this document in favour of the Purchaser.
The Purchaser will release the Performance Security without any interest to the supplier on completion of the supplier’s all contractual obligations including the warranty obligations.
4. **Technical Specifications and Standards**
The Goods & Services to be provided by the supplier under this contract shall conform to the General and standard specifications of the items issued by Govt. of India, Ministry of Petroleum.
5. **Contract period**
The contract will be for a period of **two year** from the date of award of contract, extendable for a further period of one year on the basis of satisfactory performance and on mutual agreement.
6. **Inspection, Testing and Quality Control:**
The stores will be supplied by the contractor on the basis of Manufacturer’s own Pre-dispatch Inspection Certificate. The Purchaser / consignee or its authorized representative will inspect the stores and will issue Consignee’s Receipt Certificate certifying receipt of stores in full & good conditions clearly indicating shortage / breakage, if any, for recovery of appropriate amount from the contractor’s bill.

Goods accepted by the Purchaser / consignee and / or its authorized representative during inspection in terms of the contract shall in no way dilute Purchaser 's / consignee's right to reject the same later, if found deficient in terms of the warranty clause of the Contract.

7. Terms of Delivery:

Goods shall be delivered by the supplier in accordance with the terms of delivery specified in the contract- on requirement basis.

The Successful bidder will have to provide petrol/diesel/oil etc. as per requirement of SAI for which the Dy. Director (GAD-I) for his representatives will be informing the successful bidder through POL slips (Which provided by successful bidder) duly signed.

8. Insurance:

Unless otherwise instructed, the supplier shall make arrangements for insuring the goods against loss or damage incidental to manufacture or acquisition, transportation, storage and delivery in the following manner:

- i) Wherever necessary, the goods supplied under the contract shall be fully insured in the manner specified in the contract. If considered necessary, the insurance may be done for coverage on "all risks" basis including war risks and strike clauses. The amount to be covered under insurance should be sufficient to take care of the overall expenditure, which may be incurred due to any such damage, loss etc.

- 9.** The supplier warrants comprehensively that the goods supplied under the contract is new, unused and incorporate all recent/latest improvements in design and materials unless prescribed otherwise by the Purchaser in the contract. The supplier further warrants that the goods supplied under the contract shall have no defect arising from design, materials or workmanship or from any act or omission of the supplier that may develop under normal use of the supplied goods under the conditions prevailing in India.

This warranty shall remain valid for one (01) year after the goods have been delivered and installed at the final destination and accepted by the Purchaser in terms of the contract.

The supplier shall, promptly repair or replace the defective goods or parts thereof, free of cost, at the ultimate destination. The supplier shall take over the replaced parts/goods after providing their replacements and no claim, whatsoever shall lie on the Purchaser for such replaced parts/goods thereafter.

If the supplier, having been notified, fails to rectify/replace the defect(s) promptly, the Purchaser may proceed to take such remedial action(s) as deemed fit by the Purchaser , at the risk and expense of the supplier and without prejudice to other contractual rights and remedies, which the Purchaser may have against the supplier.

Supplier shall carry sufficient inventories to assure ex-stock supply of consumable spares for the goods so that the same are supplied to the Purchaser promptly on receipt of order from the Purchaser.

11. Prices:

Prices to be charged by the supplier for supply of goods and provision of services in terms of the contract shall not vary from the corresponding prices quoted by the supplier in its Bid and incorporated in the contract.

12. Taxes, Duties and Octroi:

Supplier shall be entirely responsible for all taxes, duties, levies etc. incurred until delivery of the contracted goods to the Purchaser. Only statutory variations on finished product if stipulated in Contract shall be allowed to the extent of actual payment by the Supplier.

Octroi Duty, Local Duties & Terminal Taxes etc.:

Normally, goods to be supplied to government departments against government contracts are exempted from levy of town duty, octroi duty, terminal tax and other levies of local bodies. However, on some occasions, the local bodies (like town body, municipal body etc.) as per their regulations allow such exemptions only on production of certificate to this effect from the concerned government department. Keeping this in view, the supplier shall ensure that the stores to be supplied by the supplier against the contract placed by the Purchaser are exempted from levy of any such duty or tax and, wherever necessary, obtain the exemption certificate from the Purchaser.

However, if a local body still insists upon payment of such local duties and taxes, the same should be paid by the supplier to the local body to avoid delay in supplies and possible demurrage/detention charges and obtain a receipt for the same. The supplier should forward the receipt obtained for such payment to the Purchaser to enable the Purchaser reimburse the supplier and take other necessary action in the matter.

13. Terms and Mode of Payment:

Payment Terms

Payment shall be made subject to recoveries, if any, by way of liquidated damages or any other charges as per terms & conditions of contract in the following manner:

Payment shall be made in Indian Rupees as specified in the contract in the following manner:

1. Payment will be made on fortnightly basis on production of Invoice.
2. No advance payment will be made.
3. The Successful bidder will submit the bill to the Dy. Director (GAD) every fortnightly. SAI will make the payment through ECS /NEFT in favour of the Agency.

4. The payment shall be made fortnightly only after upon submission of the following documents: -
 - (i) Supplier's invoice showing contract number, goods description, quantity, unit price and total amount;
 - (ii) Requisition slip issued by the authorized representative of concerned section
 - (iii) Acceptance Certificate/slip.
5. No bill process charges or any others charge shall be payable to the successful bidder.
6. Payment of the contract price shall be subjected to the recoveries / liquidated damages/shortages etc., if any.
7. SAI reserves the right to deduct the TAX as applicable while making such payments.

The supplier shall not claim any interest on payments under the contract.

Where there is a statutory requirement for tax deduction at source, such deduction towards income tax and other tax as applicable will be made from the bills payable to the Supplier at rates as notified from time to time.

The supplier shall send its claim for payment in writing, when contractually due, along with relevant documents etc., duly signed with date, to the Purchaser.

All payments in Indian Rupee will be made through National Electronic Fund Transfer (NEFT)/RTGS systems as per the NEFT Mandate Form attached as per Section-IV (E).

14. Delay in the supplier's performance:

The supplier shall deliver the goods and perform the services under the contract within the time schedule specified by the Purchaser as incorporated in the contract.

Any unexcused delay by the supplier in maintaining its contractual obligations towards delivery of goods and performance of services shall render the supplier liable to any or all of the following sanctions:

- (i). Imposition of Liquidated Damages,
- (ii). Forfeiture of its Performance Security and
- (iii). Termination of the Contract for default.

15. Liquidated damages:

If the supplier fails to deliver any or all of the goods or fails to perform the services within the time frame(s) incorporated in the contract, the Purchaser shall, without prejudice to other rights and remedies available to the Purchaser under the contract, deduct from the contract price, as liquidated damages, a sum equivalent to 0.5% per occasion of delay or part thereof on delayed supply of goods and/or services until actual delivery or performance subject to a maximum of 10% of the contract price.

16. Termination for default:

The Purchaser, without prejudice to any other contractual rights and remedies available to it (the Purchaser), may, by written notice of default sent to the supplier, terminate the contract in whole or in part, if the supplier fails to deliver any or all of the goods or fails to perform any other contractual obligation(s) within the time period specified in the contract, or within any extension thereof granted by the Purchaser.

Unless otherwise instructed by the Purchaser, the supplier shall continue to perform the contract to the extent not terminated.

17. Termination for insolvency:

If the supplier becomes bankrupt or otherwise insolvent, the Purchaser reserves the right to terminate the contract at any time, by serving written notice to the supplier without any compensation, whatsoever, to the supplier, subject to further condition that such termination will not prejudice or affect the rights and remedies which have accrued and / or will accrue thereafter to the Purchaser.

18. Termination for convenience:

The Purchaser reserves the right to terminate the contract, in whole or in part for its (Purchaser's) convenience, by serving written notice on the supplier at any time during the currency of the contract. The notice shall specify that the termination is for the convenience of the Purchaser. The notice shall also indicate inter alia, the extent to which the supplier's performance under the contract is terminated, and the date with effect from which such termination will become effective.

The goods and services which are complete and ready in terms of the contract for delivery and performance within thirty days after the supplier's receipt of the notice of termination shall be accepted by the Purchaser following the contract terms, conditions and prices. For the remaining goods and services, the Purchaser may decide:

- a) To get any portion of the balance completed and delivered at the contract terms, conditions and prices; and / or
- b) To cancel the remaining portion of the goods and services and compensate the supplier by paying an agreed amount for the cost incurred by the supplier towards the remaining portion of the goods and services.

19. Fall Clause:

a) The Supplier undertakes that he has not supplied/is not supplying similar products/system or sub-systems to any department of Govt. of India i.e. Central Government/State Government, Statutory Undertakings of Central/State Governments/Local Bodies etc. and as well as to private Purchaser , domestic or foreign at a price lower than that offered in the present bid.

b) If it is found at any stage that similar product/systems or sub systems was supplied by the Supplier to any of the above Organizations as well as to private Purchaser, domestic or foreign, at a lower price, then that very price, with due allowance for elapsed time, will be applicable to the present case and the difference in the cost would be refunded by the Supplier to the Purchaser , if the contract has already been concluded.

20. Withholding and lien in respect of sums claimed:

Whenever any claim or claims for payment of a sum of money arises out of or under the contract against the Contractor, the Purchaser shall be entitled to withhold and also have a lien to retain such sum or sums in whole or in part from the security, if any, deposited by the Contractor and for the purpose aforesaid, the Purchaser shall be entitled to withhold the said cash security deposit or the security, if any, furnished as the case may be and also have a lien over the same pending finalization or adjudication of any such claim. In the event of the security being insufficient to cover the claimed amount or amounts or if no security has been taken from the Contractor, the Purchaser shall be entitled to withhold and have lien to retain to the extent of the such claimed amount or amounts referred to supra, from any sum or sums found payable or which at anytime thereafter may become payable to the Contractor under the same contract or any other contract with the Purchaser or the Government, pending finalization or adjudication of any such claim and that The Contractor shall have no claim for interest or damages whatsoever on this account or on any other ground in respect of any sum of money withheld or retained under this clause and duly notified as such to the Contractor.

21. Resolution of disputes:

If dispute or difference of any kind shall arise between the Purchaser and the supplier in connection with or relating to the contract, the parties shall make every effort to resolve the same amicably by mutual consultations.

If the parties fail to resolve their dispute or difference by such mutual consultation within twenty-one days of its occurrence, then, either the Purchaser or the supplier may give notice to the other party of its intention to commence arbitration, as hereinafter provided the applicable arbitration procedure will be as per the Arbitration and Conciliation Act, 1996 of India. Such dispute or difference shall be referred to the sole arbitration, appointed to be the arbitrator by the Director General (Sports Authority of India). The award of the arbitrator will be final and binding on the parties to the Contract.

Venue of Arbitration: The venue of arbitration shall be the place from where the contract has been issued, i.e., New Delhi, India.

22. Applicable Law:

The contract shall be governed by and interpreted in accordance with the laws of India for the time being in force.
