



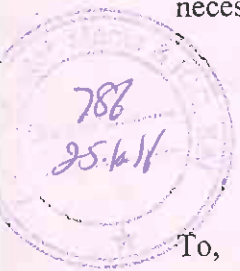

**Minutes of meeting held on 20.10.2016 at 11 AM in the DG's Conference Hall in connection with the setting up the SAI-National Billiard & Snooker Academy (SAI-National Cue Sports Academy) at Dr. SPMSPC, New Delhi**

A meeting was held on 20.10.2016 at 11 AM in the DG's Conference Hall in connection with setting up of SAI National Billiard & Snooker Academy at Dr. SPMSPC, New Delhi under the Chairmanship of DG, SAI. The following were present:-

- 2) Shri Hira Ballabh, ED (Operation)
- 3) Shri Balasubramaniam, Hony. Secretary, Billiard & Snooker Federation of India
- 4) Shri Manmeet Bhatia, representative of BSFI.
- 5) Ms. Sunita Bharal, DD (Operation).
- 6) Shri Praveen Kakkar, Administrator, Dr. SPMSPC.
- 7) Shri Ramesh, representative of BFI.
- 8) Shri Vikrant Surve, Young Professional.

The following points were discussed:-

- 1) The SAI- National Billiard & Snooker Academy (SAI-National Cue Sports Academy) can be set up at Dr. SPMSPC in two sections. Section-I for the elite players and section-II for beginners.
- 2) The Hall (Section-II) where the four existing tables are already placed can be used for the beginners. However, one more table/pool table can also be placed in the Hall. This facility can be used under the 'Come & Play' Scheme on payment of the fee @ Rs 60/- per hour or Rs 1500/- per month.
- 3) Section-I will be for the elite players and 6 new tables (4 Billiards & 2 Pool) of international standards are to be placed in this section.
- 4) The elite players shall be inducted based on a proper selection criteria.
- 5) BSFI will provide the proposal for the selection of trainees. The selected trainees would be given training free of cost.
- 6) It was decided that 4 Billiard table, 2 pool table as per the specification & brand given by Federation may be procured from the funds of ACTC (under TEAMS Division)

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through Billiard & Snooker Federation of India following due procedure. SAI will provide the custom exemption certificate.

- 7) Director General desired that the SAI-National Billiard & Snooker Academy (SAI-National Cue Sports Academy) should start with effect from 15 November 2016 and all the arrangements should be made accordingly.
- 8) The representative of BSFI informed that after the order is placed for the table, the time required for delivery at site would be approx. two months. Therefore, it was discussed that the Academy may start w.e.f. 15/11/2016 with 2-3 tables of International standard arranged by BSFI on temporary basis which will be replaced by the new ones later on.
- 9) The preparation for the Halls were discussed with the officials of BSFI. The following are the basic requirements for the Billiard Halls:-
  - i) Wall to wall carpeting – It was discussed that BSFI will provide the sample for the carpet and GAD may be asked for procurement and lying of the same urgently under the provision of GFR before the date of inauguration.
  - ii) Proper lighting arrangement in consultation with Federation.
  - iii) Game specific furniture i.e. high chair, tables etc to be procured through BSFI.
  - iv) Provision of thick curtains for the Halls.
  - v) Preparation of proper Boards and sinages.
- 10) It was also discussed that BSFI will be the technical/knowledge partner for SAI-National Billiard & Snooker Academy (SAI-National Cue Sports Academy) and will be responsible for selection of coaches/markers & SAI will bear the expenditure on their salaries. The overall administration will be under COO/Administrator SPMPC.
- 11) Display of rules and regulations, display of picture of eminent players, display of do and don'ts etc to be arranged by BSFI before the date of inauguration & SAI will bear the expenditure. The expenditure incurred by Federation would be reimbursed on production of necessary voucher etc.
- 12) It was also discussed that a players' lounge may be created for the elite players in the section-I.
- 13) It was also felt that few cues and set of Billiard & Snookers balls may also be procured for the Academy through Federation.
- 14) Arrangement of water to be made in both the sections and a small cafeteria with dry eatable items tea/coffee/cold drinks on payment may be set-up.
- 15) Formal MOU will be signed between SAI & BSFI specifying the responsibility of both.

The meeting concluded with the vote of thanks.

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
